#### **Old Business:**

1. 2018 Chamber Golf Classic: Friday, June 15, 2018
  - a. What went well?
    - i. Food lasted and was good
    - ii. Door prizes went smoother
    - iii. Chipping contest went smoother but will make even easier for next year
    - iv. Everyone was having fun; no issues with intoxicated people
    - v. Overall it went a lot smoother
    - vi. Income-Expense:
      1. Overall a profit of \$6,000 on a one-day golf tournament is very good
      2. Betting Hole went well
      3. 50/50 went very well
      4. Fantasy Golf Card went very well
      5. Down about \$800 in profit
      6. Teams down \$500 due to 2 less teams
      7. Golf Fees went up-\$300 more even with 2 less teams
        - a. 3-4 weeks before the event
  - b. What to change?
    - i. Beer carts stopped towards the end and people got frustrated (could have been a reason they stopped)
    - ii. Potential different hole for Advance to Jr Tee-either way you will have a pile up
