CITY HALL REOPENS WITH REDUCED HOURS

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – (South Haven, Michigan) June 3, 2020 - City Hall will reopen to the public with temporary reduced lobby hours on Monday, June 8, 2020. This change follows Governor Whitmer’s Executive Order 2020-110.

The City will implement prevention practices recommended by public health authorities to reopen safely and responsibly, including, but not limited to:

- Installation of protective barriers at front counters and social distancing floor markings
- Posting of physical distancing for employees and visitors in prominent areas
- Recommendation for customers to use face coverings inside the building
- Requiring employees to use face coverings when interacting with customers
- Frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitizer
- Weekly anti-microbial fogging and regular cleaning and disinfection of surfaces
- Employee training and information on the elements of the COVID-19

Customers are still encouraged to conduct as much business as possible by either phone or online options during regular business hours: Monday – Friday, 8am-5pm. Counters in front lobby will have reduced hours: Monday – Friday, 10am-3pm. Appointments can be scheduled during the reduced hour period as needed by calling City Hall.

“Our top priority is making sure the community and workforce remains safe.” said Kate Hosier, Interim City Manager. “We continue to follow state guidelines which support a safe and responsible reopening of our city and the services available at City Hall.”
