

# Leadership Hartsville Class of 2021 Application

Deadline to apply: August 19, 2020, 5 p.m.

#### Instructions

Thank you for applying to Leadership Hartsville. In order for us to process your application, we ask that you complete the application according to the following instructions:

- Complete the questions and add additional pages as necessary. Please label each additional page with the question you are answering.
- Applications (pages 3-5 and essay responses) must be received by CLOSE OF BUSINESS (5 p.m.) August 19, 2020.
- Please note that the application must be signed by both the applicant and his/her employer.
- All applicants will be notified of their status by August 21, 2020.

#### Selection Considerations

Each Leadership Hartsville class is chosen by a selection committee that strives to achieve balance in the class by ensuring diversity of race, gender, industry, professional backgrounds and leadership experience. Classes are representative of our community and include participants who represent large and small businesses, the self-employed, nonprofit organizations and community volunteers. Applications will be thoroughly reviewed.

Selection considerations include:

- Participation eligible to all individuals who live or work in the Greater Hartsville area
- Commitment to personal and professional growth
- Commitment and motivation to serve the community by assuming leadership roles in the voluntary and public sectors of our community
- Commitment to improving the community environment to favorably impact the economic development and quality of life in our community
- Length of time in the community

The Leadership Hartsville program will be highly competitive. A limited number of applicants are selected for each class, so if your application is not accepted this program year we encourage re-application to subsequent classes.

## **Program Tuition**

In addition to time and dedication, Leadership Hartsville requires a financial commitment. In order to keep the cost to a minimum for the participants, the program does get sponsorships from the business community for the program days, retreats and graduation. Tuition and sponsorships cover all program costs including two two-day retreats, facilitator costs, materials and meals provided during each program day, graduation dinner and any necessary transportation needs.

If the participant drops from the class before September 5, a refund will be provided less a \$150 administrative fee. There will be no refunds after September 5.

#### Scholarships:

**Small Business Scholarship:** One half scholarship, valued at \$375, will be awarded to an owner/employee of a small business (less than 50 employees). New Member Incentive Price or 110% Club Member Price not applicable to scholarship.

**Nonprofit Scholarship:** One full scholarship, valued at \$750, will be awarded to an employee of a nonprofit organization (501c3 status only).

Those wishing to apply for a scholarship should complete the separate scholarship application and return it with the class application by the August 16 deadline. The applications will be blackened to keep the applicant's identity confidential. A committee of Leadership Hartsville graduates and community representatives will choose scholarship recipients. The class selection committee, when making decisions, does not consider a request for scholarship assistance.

#### Tuition is due by September 1, 2020.

### Program Participant Responsibilities

Leadership Hartsville provides its participants with the opportunity to engage in an exciting 9 months of personal, professional and community exploration and it does require a time commitment.

The program begins with a two-day retreat in September. Classes meet for all-day "program days" on one Wednesday of each month, usually the first or third Wednesday, from October through May. A second two-day retreat is also held in February. Class members are allowed to miss a <u>total</u> of 8 hours per year, excluding the retreats, which are mandatory. A special graduation luncheon concludes the class in May.

To enrich the Leadership Hartsville experience and increase community engagement, in addition to the retreats and program days, a class project will be selected and participation will be mandatory. Participants who are unable to meet the requirements of the program will be dropped with no refund. Following the completion of the program, participants are expected to stay involved in the organization, continually enhancing their Leadership experience and helping to strengthen the program for the future.

#### Time Commitment

Participation in Leadership Hartsville program requires a major time commitment. Participants are expected to attend ALL sessions. Emergency absences are not permitted for the retreats.
