Requirements & Information

Attached you will find the entry form for the **Annual Fall Festival Parade**. Start time will be at **10 am** Saturday, September 24th. The theme for this year's parade is : **“Wild Wild West”** and our **Grand Marshal is White Mountain Sheriff's Posse**. The Theme must be incorporated into your float/entry. Check in/line up will begin at 7am on September, 24 2016 in the parking lot across from Compass Bank.

There will be a **fee of \$250 for political (this includes your banner or sign displayed as an entertainment sponsor on Saturday at Fall Festival), \$30 for commercial, and \$20 for all other entries**. The Chamber of Commerce is a non-profit organization; this fee will help defray some of the set-up costs such as organizing, advertising, printing and application mailings.

The Parade will end at the entrance to the **Blue Ridge School District** where your participants can disembark in their parking lot. Please plan on parking at the **Blue Ridge Schools**.

AWARDS Judging and Awards will be done prior to the parade. This is a change from previous years. The judging will take place from 8:30am to 9:30am. All floats

must be lined up and ready for judging by 8:30am, no exceptions. The Award winners will be given a banner to display on their float for the parade. **There will be a \$250 Grand Prize for the “The Duke Award” Best Overall!!! So go the extra mile!**

NOTES

All entries must be decorated in keeping with the theme “Wild Wild West”.

Advertising a business or person without this theme is unacceptable.

Any & all entries with children riding bikes, horses or ATV’s MUST have helmets for anyone under the age of 18. This is state law!

All entrants are encouraged to incorporate music into their entry.

In case of an emergency situation during the course of the parade, police want the parade to **move to the right lane so emergency equipment can get through.**

FINALLY

NO CANDY THROWING FROM VEHICLES! If you would like to have people walking along your entry and toss from the sidewalk into the crowd, that would be acceptable. This year we will have “**PARADE POLICE**”, their job is to prevent gaps between parade participants and make sure that all spectators and participants are safe.
