EACH VENDOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Reading, understanding and following all Lodi Farmers Market Rules and Regulations. These rules and regulations are available on-line at www.lodichamber.com or at the Chamber office.
- The winegrower or winegrower’s agent shall only sell wine that is produced entirely from grapes or other agricultural products grown and bottled by the winegrower.
- Provide instructional tastings for consumers on the subject of wine.
- The winegrower or winegrower’s agent shall not permit any consumer to leave the instructional tasting area with an open container of wine.
- The winegrower or winegrower’s agent shall not pour more than three ounces of wine per person per day.
- Assembling and staffing own booth
- Purchasing/supplying all materials and equipment necessary to properly and safely run the booth
- Comply with all Police and Fire Department Rules and Regulations (Fire Department: 209-333-6735)
- Collection and handling of money for their business
- Booth display sign(s)
- Cleaning your area after the event. Leaving no trash. Space MUST be left as found.
- No selling outside of your space is allowed
- Complete and sign the mandatory **Liability Clause** below. Return original signed copy with Application. Keep a copy of all paperwork for your records.
- One space is 10’ x 10’, however additional spaces can be rented.
- You may not sell any items not listed and approved by the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce.
- Following all local, state and federal laws governing this area.

CHAMBER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Assign and provide a barrier for the winegrower’s area
- Restrooms
- San Joaquin County Temporary Event Permit
- Advertising
- Send vendor space assignment no later than the Monday before the date of the event

NOTE: One embossed copy of your Certified Producer’s Certificate and Liability Insurance must be enclosed with this application. I am applying for a space in the Lodi Farmer’s Market. I understand and agree that there is a 48 hour cancellation policy with no exceptions. I agree to this arrangement. No refunds without 48 hours’ notice.

RAINOUT POLICY: The Market will take place RAIN or SHINE. There are **NO** rainout refunds.

Submitting this application is not guaranteed acceptance of your space in the market. Past participants will be given priority consideration.
