"The challenge is how to manipulate the paint and then control what the colors do as the paint decides how to flow," she said.

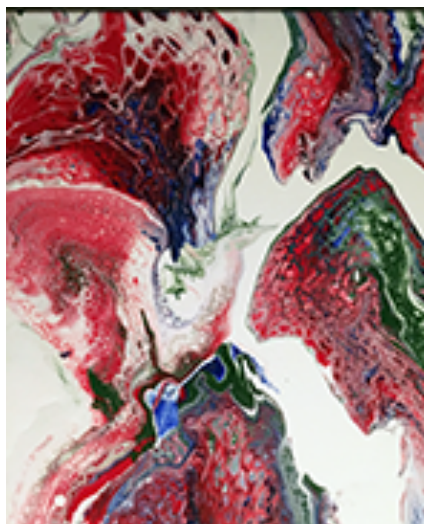

Too bad it won't be an interactive demo, but this innovative technique is also very messy, she said.

She will, instead, do several pours and distribute a list of supplies. This includes gloves and apron, but also popsicle sticks, push pins, paper towels, large straws, and a basin to catch overflows. etc. You get the idea. Of course, the demo is free.

PARTICIPANTS PRACTICE AT ADOBE'S SUMI-E PAINTING DEMO IN JULY



Demonstrator Kazumi Cranney led the way, expertly painting a spray of wheat, (below right). Those who attended the demo enthusiastically tried to do the same, (examples left).

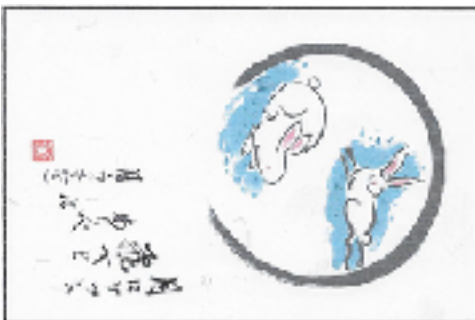
When the would-be artists arrived, the room's long tables were set like a banquet--with place settings of a brush, dish of ink, glass of water and papers.

Kazumi first demonstrated the complex strokes. They do look simple, but the technique requires lots of practice.



An ink stone is used with added water to create the ink. This Japanese art traditionally carries a seal, carefully placed, and images made with watercolors.
