### **Alberta Business Awards of Distinction**

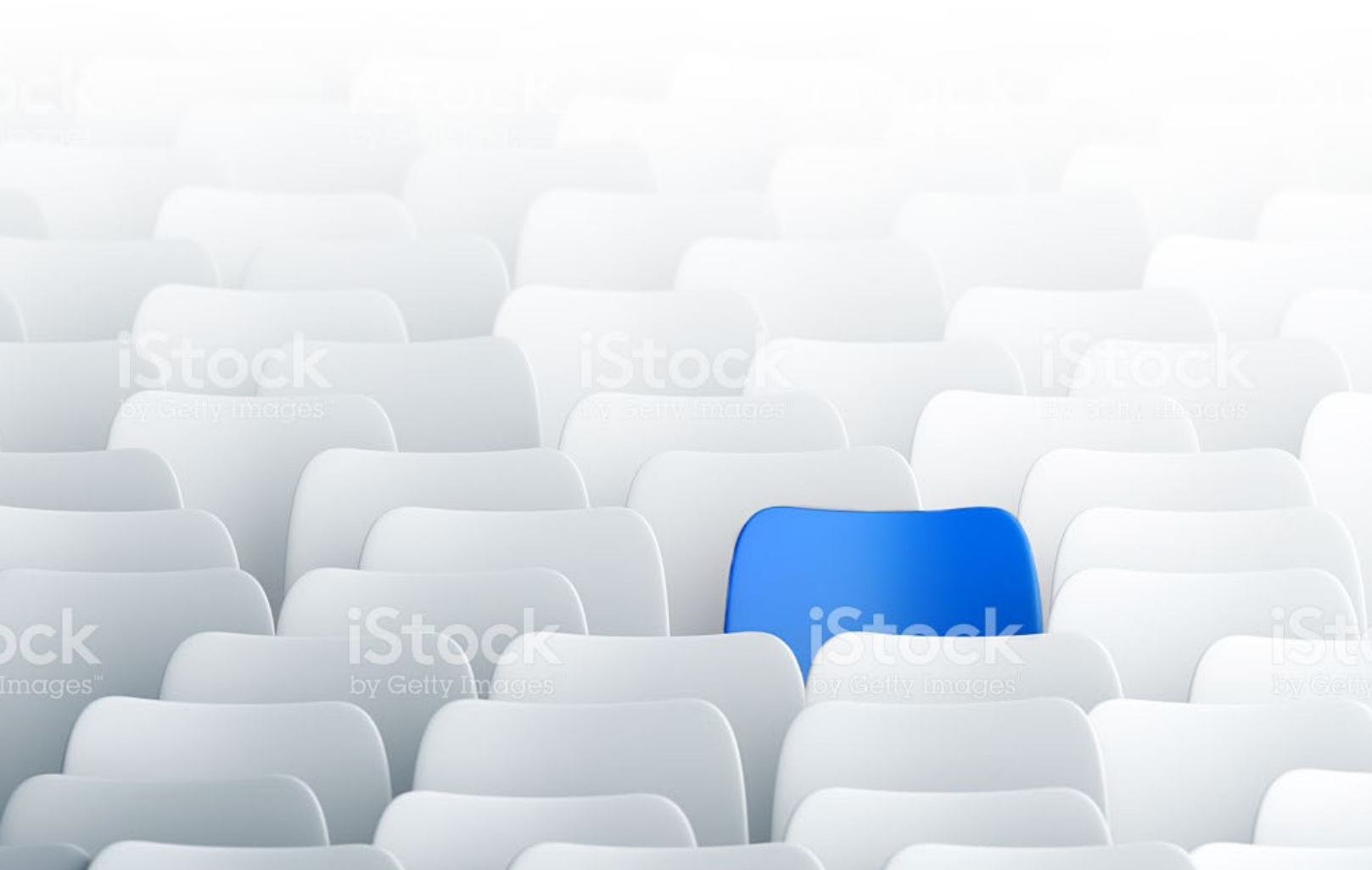
