Leadership Tulare is a program developed to prepare, involve, and sustain leaders from diverse backgrounds who are committed and competent to address community challenges in Tulare.

Objectives:

- Select men and women from a variety of geographic, ethnic, institutional and economic backgrounds with an interest in and the leadership ability to address emerging and ongoing community issues.
- Prepare the participants with information, training, activities, experiences and motivation to assume responsible and demanding roles in solving a variety of community challenges.
- Involve our emerging leaders through simulation and assignment in using their talent, resources and expertise to address community problems.
- Sustain the involvement, interest and association of current and emerging leaders.
- Through the program curricula, participants will develop and refine their leadership skills as they meet current leaders, participate in problem solving discussions and observe the operation of community efforts.

Application Instructions

1. Respond to the five topics listed on page 2 of the application. Please use additional paper to respond to these subjects. All responses must be concise, typewritten and no more than a total of two (2) pages.
2. Submit two (2) letters of reference: one personal and one professional. The letters must be current and typewritten.
3. Complete the contract on page 4 of this application packet in order to be considered for the Leadership Tulare program. Please be certain that you have original signatures on the application when it is submitted to the Tulare Chamber of Commerce. Your signature indicates your agreement to abide by the requirements of the Leadership Tulare program which includes payment of fees, attendance, participation, and program assignments.
4. Attend an interview with the Leadership Tulare Selection Committee to be scheduled in August 2019. You will be notified regarding interview times after the application deadline. Professional attire is recommended.

Program Topics

Sessions on local history, agriculture, media, economic development, government and politics, health, education, quality of life, cultural diversity, leadership development, communication and group dynamics will be included in the curriculum. The program will begin in September with the Orientation and Welcome Reception, followed by a two-day Retreat, September 26 & 27, 2019.

Program Requirements

If selected to participate in the Leadership Tulare Class of 2019-2020, you will be required to:

1. Pay \$750 tuition (\$850 Non-member)
Fee – \$150 to be paid by the participant on or before September 5, 2019; and the remaining \$600 to be paid in full by the sponsor or employer **by September 5, 2019.** Participant employer/sponsor fees are non-refundable in the event the participant voluntarily leaves the program any time after the opening reception or is removed from the program. **Limited Scholarships and payment plans may be available if requested.**
2. **Attend ALL Day Sessions** of the program in addition to the opening reception/orientation and a two day retreat. Day sessions last from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, one session per month from October through May, and may include extra-curricular assignments and/or research. Attendance at all sessions is required. In the event of an emergency, one excused absence may be granted with *prior* approval of the Leadership Tulare Performance Chair, provided that make-up requirements outlined in the Attendance Policy are met. Make up assignments will be directed by the Leadership Tulare Performance Chair and may include community service, make up with another Leadership program, or other assignments at the discretion of the Performance Chair. **Attendance is mandatory for the Retreat and the Sacramento Trip, no exceptions.**
3. **Attend ALL Evening Sessions.** These sessions are designed to develop personal leadership skills and final session will last approximately 2 hours (6:00-8:00pm) and will be held on the first Thursday of each month. In the event of an emergency, one excused absence may be granted with prior approval of the Leadership Tulare Performance Chair, provided that make-up requirements outlined in the Attendance Policy are met. Make up assignments will be directed by the Leadership Tulare Facilitator and may include community service, make up with another Leadership program, or other assignments at the discretion of the Performance Chair.

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5. **Class Projects: Coordinate and complete a community service project and class fund-raising project.** The community impact project must be directed toward a cause the entire class agrees to work on. The fundraising project is has a required minimum of \$10,000 net proceeds. Funds are be used to support the Leadership Tulare Program and keep tuition low for the subsequent year(s). Planning of the projects will be done outside of normal session time.
6. **Have the support and commitment of your employer.** You will need a signature from your employer on page 3 of this application, indicating that they are aware that you may be participating in this program during normal operating hours and that they give permission for you to be absent from work during those times.
7. **All participants are required to attend at least one City Council meeting and a Chamber Government Affairs Committee meeting as well as a volunteer at the Chamber's Annual Awards & Installation Banquet.**
8. **Reside or be employed within the greater Tulare area.**
9. **Be a minimum age of 21 years.**
