MONROVIA GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TUES APRIL 11, 2017 -- NOMINATION PERIOD

As determined by the Elections Code, the filing period for candidates is December 19, 2016, through January 13, 2017. City Clerk office hours will be posted in the lobby. Nomination Papers may be taken out and returned during regular working hours, 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., Monday through Thursday, and 7:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M. on Fridays. In the event that an incumbent does not file for reelection, the Nomination Period for the office being vacated by the incumbent will be extended to the following Wednesday, January 18, 2017, at 6:00 P.M.

Those seats that are up for re-election are held by Mayor Tom Adams (a two-year term) , Mayor Pro Tem Alexander C. Blackburn, Council Member Larry J. Spicer, City Clerk Alice D. Atkins, and City Treasurer Steve Baker (each being a four-year term).

Staff encourages those who wish to take out Nomination Papers to call the City Clerk’s office for an appointment, as each candidate is given an orientation lasting about one-half hour and a Candidate’s Handbook prepared by staff. Staff also cautions each candidate not to wait until the last day of filing to return his / her Nomination Papers and election-related documents as, in the event that anything is lacking, there is no additional time to submit materials after the filing deadline.

The City Clerk’s Office is also working to coordinate a pre-nomination period orientation program for prospective candidates. The intent of the seminar is to give those interested for running for office an overview of the election process and an idea of what it entails to run for an elected City position. Members of the public who are not interested in running for public office but would like to know more about the election are also welcome to attend.
