Registration: Complete the form below and email or mail it to the address above. Line up locations will be assigned for all entries received on or before February 1, 2018. *Please note, line up is based on a "first come first served" basis (with the exception of school bands).*

Parade Line up: Line-up will begin at 9:00am; Parade will begin at 10:00am and judging will occur during the parade. Line- up will be from Maple Avenue to 7th Street. Please try to avoid using side streets so that we can keep them open for traffic. Parade officials, known as the Vigilantes, will be located at every intersection beginning on the corner of Maple and 5th street to assist parade participants.

Judging & Awards: The judging process is based on a numerical point system. All entries will have the option to be judged or not. Prizes will be awarded 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in each category. A Sweepstakes trophy will be awarded for Best Use of Theme for all non-band entries. Here are the following categories:

- Floats
- Drill Team
- Vehicle
- Equestrian
- Walking Performance
- Bands (includes flag & shields)
- Participation Entries

Note: cheer squads, color guards and official vehicles will not be judged.

****All vehicle participants THERE WILL BE NO PEELING, BURN OUTS, SPEEDING ETC. Violators will be removed and cited immediately by the Holtville Sheriff Dept.**

Parade Route: The Parade route begins at the corner of Maple Avenue & 5th Street and runs West to Main Street, turns North onto Cedar Avenue where the parade will end. **Note: A parade official will be available to assist you at the time of line-up.**

- Each parade entry must have a completed registration form prior to the start of the parade.
- The Holtville Chamber reserves the right to refuse any parade entry.
- For the SAFETY of our viewers, please DO NOT THROW CANDY or any other items from your entry. If you would like to distribute candy and other materials we recommend to have walkers alongside.
