

# THE RULES



## MUST HAVE:

**Waiver:** All participants must sign a waiver to receive a wristband. On-line pre-registration process provides the waiver electronically. Children 13-17 years old must have a waiver signed by the parent/guardian and be accompanied by that parent/guardian. Children 12 and under may not enter the float

**Wristband:** \$20 All Participants must have a wristband– Purchase online at [www.parkerfun.com](http://www.parkerfun.com)

**US Coast Guard Approved Life Jacket** – Not Provided

**Inflatable Tube/Float** – Not Provided **DO NOT INFLATE YOUR TUBES PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT THE LAUNCH SITE.**

**INFLATION STATIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT BUCKSKIN MOUNTAIN STATE PARK. DUMPSTERS WILL BE ON BEACH FOR EASY DISPOSAL OF YOUR TUBE BOXES AND TRASH PRIOR TO LAUNCH. No more than 10 tubes tied together.** All floats must be removed from the water after landing at the finish line, deflated and placed in personal vehicle or thrown away in receptacles provided.

**Trash Bag** – Provided by Organizer **Anyone found dumping trash in the river or on the land is subject to a fine, removal from the event and/or arrest**

**Vessel Registration:** \$25 You will need to provide the following information when registering: state in which it is registered, make and the registration number (The combination of letters and numbers located on the side of the craft) One vessel per floating group will be allowed. Vessel **MUST** stay with floating group during event. Vessel is to be used to keep floaters in the middle of the river. Insurance and registration must be current. **Vessels not associated with a float group will not be allowed in the event area. Operators of vessels may not consume alcoholic beverages.**

**La Paz County Park Parking Fee** - \$10 Cash – Participants who drop their party off at the launch site will drive their vehicle to La Paz County Park for convenient parking at the finish line. The fee to park at La Paz County Park is \$10. Bring cash. A shuttle will transport drivers of the personal vehicles back to the launch at Buckskin Mountain State Park to join their group. Drivers of personal vehicles will receive a shuttle ticket upon exiting Buckskin Mountain State Park and must present that ticket to the driver of the shuttle at La Paz County Park for transportation back to Buckskin Mountain State Park.

## NOT PERMITTED:

**Kegs or Unlawful Substances**

**Homemade Floats, Plywood, Barrels, Docking Material**

**Glass**

**Styrofoam**

**Soufflé Cups (ie- Jello Shooters)**

**Water Balloons**

**Littering:** Anyone found dumping trash in the river or on the land is subject to a fine, removal from the event and/or arrest

**WE DO NOT ENCOURAGE THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DURING THIS EVENT. OPERATORS OF VESSELS MAY NOT CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. WE ASK THAT YOU “FLOAT RESPONSIBLY,” STAY OFF PRIVATE PROPERTY AND MAKE SURE ALL YOUR TRASH GETS DEPOSITED IN THE MANY RECEPTICLES AVAILABLE ON THAT DAY. PACK IT IN; PACK IT OUT.**
