Items to remember:

- Students must be enrolled as a senior at a public or private school located in Staunton City, Augusta County or Waynesboro City, or be homeschooled in one of those localities.
- If awarded, students will be expected to attend a reception at Blue Ridge Community College to accept their award at 6:30pm on May 18th.
- Before the scholarship can be paid, students must provide one of the following:
 - Provide evidence of an intent to enroll in a university, community college, other institution or certification program by providing acceptance letter and class schedule.
 - Letter of employment listing job title and start date from an employer alongside a list of required personal tools/equipment necessary for the job.
- All Academic Achiever Scholarships must be claimed by January 29, 2021. Scholarships can be used for Summer 2020, Fall 2020 or Spring 2021.

Items to submit:

- List of all school & community activities including jobs, apprenticeships, and internships for the 2019-2020 academic year.
- Please provide proof of GPA which can be an unofficial transcript or report card.
- In two to three sentences, describe your intentions to further your education.
- Submit one of the following:
 - One-page typed essay describing a personal or academic challenge that you have faced and what you learned from it.
 - One minute video illustrating your work products, what you are passionate about, or other creative ideas that illustrate your character and work ethic.
- Submit up to two one-page, typed character references from a teacher, counselor, employer, coach, or pastor (non-family member).
