



The Leadership Owasso program is designed to develop strong leaders in the Owasso area who are interested in expanding their knowledge in the areas of government, education, economic development and quality of life initiatives. Leadership Owasso is a community based program that will increase the participant's knowledge of, commitment to and involvement in Owasso, the City Without Limits. The 8 session program begins in October each year and ends the following May with a group trip to the State Capitol. Graduates are presented with their certificate at the June Monthly Luncheon.

You will meet new people—business and community leaders. You will get to know your classmates well and form lifelong friendships and community partners. You will also be interacting with dignitaries from around the state.

Participants are selected for their diversity of experiences, therefore, you will hear perspectives that are deeply felt, strongly supported and perhaps different from your own. You will have many opportunities to share your experiences and beliefs with others who have not heard your voice before.

You will reinforce and energize your commitment to community service. As a result of Leadership Owasso, you will be considerably more effective in your business and community work.

You **Must** Make A Time Commitment

All participants in the Leadership Owasso class are incredibly busy people from all walks of life. Your application indicates your commitment to attend and participate in **all** classes.

Attendance at the Orientation class and the Final class are mandatory in order to graduate from this program. Participants **must** attend each class in its entirety.

You may miss **no more** than one class during the year in order to successfully complete the program.

If more than one class is missed, you **MUST** make up the missed classes during the following year before you receive your graduation certificate. There is an additional cost involved for make-up sessions.

Tuition and Assistance

Tuition is \$795 and must be paid in full on or before October 1, 2019. Tuition will cover all of your program materials and meals. Take advantage of our early bird rate by applying before June 1st to save \$200.

SELECTION CRITERIA – The most important factor in Leadership Owasso’s selection process is the identification of those individuals most likely to use their leadership for the long-term benefit of the community. Leadership Owasso selects individuals who aim to enhance their knowledge of Owasso and actively participate in its future. Participants must possess a sincere desire to serve their community. In addition, participants are selected to represent the diversity of the Owasso community. Factors considered in the selection process include:

Organizational Leadership - Past, present, and potential leadership roles in organizations.

Community Involvement – Past, present, or desired future involvement in elective or volunteer capacities.

Motivation – Level of motivation to take full advantage of the opportunities offered by Leadership Owasso and remain active as a Leadership Owasso member.

Time Commitment – Ability and interest to complete the Leadership Owasso program and to contribute to the Owasso community in the future.
