CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Class members must: (1.) *Reside in Dickson County* Or (2.) *Work in Dickson County* Or (3.) *Make a significant contribution to Dickson County through volunteer work.*

Participants will be selected each year who are most apt to utilize their leadership ability for the long-term benefit of the community and whose inclusion in that year's class furthers the objective of the program to bring together persons with diverse backgrounds and interests.

Persons will be favored for selection who:

1. *Have demonstrated a desire to serve the community by past civic activities.*
2. *Are willing to seek leadership roles on public and private boards, in volunteer organizations, or in public office.*
3. *Are motivated to improve their skills.*
4. *Have an occupation such that they are not likely to be relocating from the county in the immediate future.*
5. *Will commit to participate fully in the Leadership Dickson County program, meet its attendance requirements, and as alumni continue their involvement with the program for at least one year as resource persons, program planners, Board members, or other roles as needed.*

ATTENDANCE POLICY

2019-20 program days are scheduled as follows: September 20, Opening; September 21, Challenge Course; October 24, History; November 14, Social Services; December 19, Public Utilities; January 16, City/County Government; February 20, Education; March 25, (Wednesday), State Government; April 16, Economic Development/Tourism; May 7, Health Care; May 19, (Tuesday), Communication/What's Next?; May 19, (evening), Graduation.

Any necessary schedule changes will be announced as soon as possible. Some individual activities will be required outside of scheduled program days. Each participant will be required to attend each of the following before the graduation date of the current year's class: (1) a City Council meeting (participant's choice of any city council inside Dickson County); (2) a Board of Education meeting; and (3) a County Commission meeting. Participation in a service project by the class as a whole, that will benefit a local non-profit or promote Dickson County, will also be required. Additionally, each participant will be required to do 4 hours of community service work that will benefit the community or a local non-profit organization. If you are unable to make this commitment, it is not in your best interest to apply at this time.

The LDC policy on attendance is as follows:

1. *A class member must attend all of both opening retreat days (September 20 & 21) to continue in the class. A class member missing the retreat will be refunded his or her tuition, and may reapply for next year's class.*
2. *Any absence from scheduled program days MAY be cause of automatic expulsion from the class. Each absence will be evaluated expeditiously by the LDC president and/or board and the decision to expel or allow the student to continue with make up work is final. Classes missed due to death in the immediate family or a serious illness of the class member are examples of allowable absences with make up work required by the class member to stay in the class.*

****Tuition will not be refunded under any circumstance for failure to finish the program.****
