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## Artisan Exhibitor Rules & Guidelines

Please return the attached application sheet **no later than Monday, August 14**. The number of participants in each category will be limited so the earlier you submit your application, the better your chances of being accepted.

This is a **JURIED SHOW: fine arts and handcrafted items only**. All items must be made by **the artist in the application**. Wine, food and regionally themed works are encouraged. Vendors may register for one business per booth; sharing booths is not allowed.

All booths must be ready at **9:30 a.m.**, September 16, and **remain open until 5:00 p.m.** Packing-up early may result in denial of participation in future events. This is a rain or shine event. A registration is a commitment to show. **No REFUNDS, no EXCEPTIONS.**

Each exhibitor must provide his or her own display, tables and chairs. Be prepared for any weather, this is an **OUTDOOR** event. Freestanding canopies are recommended and must be securely staked down and/or weighted. Any stakes, weights or other “tie-down” equipment must remain inside booth dimensions. This will be strictly enforced. Be considerate of your neighbors as well as visitors to your booth. Vendor spaces are on natural ground/gravel. Some spots may have uneven terrain within the assigned space, come prepared. **There is no electrical power available**. You may bring a “quiet” generator if electricity is needed.

Single booth dimensions are 10' x 10'. Each vendor is responsible for collecting and reporting appropriate sales tax. Note that pets are not allowed on State Historic Site properties.

All booths must remain clean and presentable at all times. Your display should be attractive and operated in good taste. No illegal, immoral, disruptive or dangerous items will be tolerated. The White County Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to disallow inappropriate items or items not listed on your application. Violation of these restrictions could result in the closing of your booth and immediate expulsion from the premises.

No participant may sell items bearing insignia pertaining to the White County Chamber of Commerce, or other agencies involved in the festival.

**Booth set-up:** Friday evening (times to be announced)  
Saturday, 6:00-9:30 AM.

**All vehicles must be moved from the vendor area by 8:30 AM.** There will be designated vendor parking.

**Take-down:** you may begin taking down your display at 5:00 PM. All trash generated during the festival must be **removed** at the conclusion of the event. Bring your own trash bags; do not use festival trash cans to dispose of your booth's trash. The area should be in the same condition when you leave as when you arrived.
