2019 CRAFT BEER GUIDELINES

Space Rental:

- Spaces are assigned by the St. Germain Chamber of Commerce.
- A beer list is requested 2 weeks prior to the event.
- The St. Germain Chamber of Commerce will be the sole vendor of additional alcoholic beverages.
- This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Wisconsin and ordinances of Vilas County and the Town of St. Germain, Wisconsin.
- Proof of Liability Insurance must be turned in before an application will be processed. The exhibitor will be the sole responsible party in regard to the safety of its exhibit that may result in loss or injury to its employees or the public. The exhibitor releases, holds, keeps and saves harmless and indemnifies both the St. Germain Chamber of Commerce and the Town of St. Germain, Wisconsin from all claims for loss, damage or injury. Exhibitors are required to carry a one million dollar insurance policy naming the St. Germain Chamber of Commerce, as "additional insured".

Space Appearance:

- No chairs or displays are allowed outside of your assigned area.
- All displays and exhibits must comply with the rules and regulations of the local fire department. Fire exits, alleys and aisles must be kept open at all times.
- All trash from your space must be disposed of prior to your departure. There are ample trash receptacles available.

Show Times and Rules:

- Set-up time begins at 6:30 AM for Colorama.
- Show hours are 9:00 AM 4:00 PM. Pints in the Park runs from 12:00 PM 4:00 PM
- All vehicles must be moved to the assigned parking area by 8:30 AM.
- Please do not begin dismantling until the posted closing time of 4:00 PM for Colorama.

Harassment or verbal abuse of anyone associated with the event or guests is strictly prohibited. Any complaints regarding such conduct will result in the removal of the exhibitor. All space contracts are non-refundable and non-transferable.
