Discover Wisconsin's and Boondock Nation's Radar Run set for February 2 & 3, 2018

St. Germain, WI, January 4, 2018:

Discover Wisconsin and Boondock Nation proudly presents the 15th Annual 2018 St. Germain Radar Run on Friday, February 2nd and Saturday February 3rd on the West Bay of Little St. Germain Lake. The St. Germain Radar Run is home of the fastest shaved ice track in Wisconsin! This two day event is packed full of fun for the snowmobile enthusiast. Races both days will take place on two tracks: the Twilight Bar 660' groomed snow track and Thunderbird Pass 1000' shaved ice track. Race entrance fee for the 660' groomed snow track is \$5 per run or 5 runs for \$20. Race entrance fee for the 1000' shaved ice track is \$25 which includes 3 runs; extra runs will cost \$5 each or 5 for \$20. There is a \$40 entrance fee for "Open Modified Unlimited Classes." Brought back by popular demand this year is the fastest three times by females each day on either track will win Divas SnowGear. Registration at the Hiller's Pine Haven Registration Booth for the races begins at noon on Friday and 9am on Saturday. From 12-8pm on Friday and 10am-4pm on Saturday food and beverages will be available by the Bo-Boen Snowmobile Club in the Sprecher's Heated Beer Tent. Beverages at this year's event will be donated by Sprecher and General Beer Northwoods. Enjoy music, presented by Badger Glass & Don Ricks Insurance of Baraboo, both days as well as Vendor's Row displays by Parsons of Eagle River.

There is more to do beyond racing the Twilight Bar 660' and Thunderbird Pass 1000'. From 1-4pm test your sled on 1000' of shaved ice or 660' of groomed snow for the Knitt's Hardware Speed Runs. 32 classes will compete for the top 3 speeds and win Fly Racing Gear. Sno*Boss Groomers sponsored Fun Runs are open to the public on both tracks as well. *Friday Night Under the Lights* activities (5-8pm), sponsored by Timbers Bar & Grill include: Snow Outlaw Drag Racing *Under the Lights* where you can watch the 10 fastest sleds in the Midwest compete on the snow for top honors. Sno*Boss Fun Runs on *Friday Night Under the Lights* on the 660' snow track is open to everyone, only \$5 per run. New this year, Arrowhead Groomers is sponsoring Heads Up Drag Racing races which will be open to all spectators. Are you really faster than your friends sled? Here's your chance to show it *Under the Lights* in front of the crowd.

If you haven't had enough on Friday, come on back on Saturday for another day of snowmobile fun. Registration for runs open at 9am. From 10am-4pm enjoy Fun Runs sponsored by Sno*Boss Groomers & Speed Runs sponsored by Knitt's Hardware. Enjoy grocery cart races during the day and around 1pm, it will be time for the Knocker's Pizza Company Bikini Run featuring Divas SnowGear. Proceeds from the Knocker's Pizza Co. Bikini Run races will be donated to the Pink Ribbon Riders, St. Germain Fire Department and Plum Lake Ambulance. Following the Bikini

Races, around 3pm, will be the Snow Outlaw Winter National Finale and throughout the rest of the afternoon Speed Runs on Shaved Ice and Top 10 Snow Outlaw Racing Finale. Port Tree Timing systems, sponsored by Kaig Stand, will be providing the timing for the Runs both days. The Trophy Presentation and Prizes for the top Three Speeds in each class, including a \$500 purse presentation for top speed of the day, will be held at Knockers Pizza at 5pm on Saturday. Cash purses for the top speed over 170 mph and top speed over 180 mph will be awarded. Also, all women compete for the top 3 speeds on both tracks to win Divas SnowGear, and that's open to any spectator!
