### Business of the Year Award - Small, Medium & Large

London's most prestigious business awards. Established in 1982, the Business of the Year Award acknowledges and celebrates high achievement in London's business community. Recognizes one small company (1 to 10 employees), one medium company (11 to 49 employees) and one large company (50+ employees) for outstanding performance. Institutional facilities and non-profit organizations are not eligible. To be eligible, a company must have been operating for at least 2 years in the private sector.

Nominees are judged on the following criteria: Business Achievements; Innovations in Service, Product or Technology; Management/Employee Relations; Employee Training and Development; Contribution to Employment Base in London; Commitment to Community; Environment.
