

Dear Trinity Church Family,

As you are aware the guidelines now for public gatherings have been limited to no more than 10 people. In light of this recent development we have decided to cancel all church activities and worship services through Wednesday, April 1st. This also includes the congregational meeting that was scheduled for Sunday night. We will be meeting weekly to continually reassess the situation which seems to be ever changing so please continue to pray for God's leading and wisdom.

Because of these restrictions – we have begun to put together a plan for making a worship service available to you through the internet and our website. Pastor Paul will be recording his sermon for this Sunday and it will be posted on the website and app by late Friday afternoon. Pastor Paul will be taking a temporary break from his current series on the book of Job and focusing the next three Sundays on the issue of Overcoming Fear and Worry.

Beginning Sunday, March 29 we hope to livestream the sermon along with a time of worship. More details about this will be made available next week. We understand not everyone is set up to participate in a live stream service. Please know, however, that the sermon will continue to be posted on the app and website like it has been every week for the past several years.

We know right now how vitally important it is for us to be good at staying in connection with you. In order to do that we will be recording 5 to 7-minute videos with important information regarding the ministry throughout the week. It is our goal to begin these videos next week. We will also include information at the beginning of the live stream for you as well.

One last thing for now, as you are well aware, the ministry here at Trinity is dependent upon your faithful giving. We have already begun to cut back on spending with the uncertainty of what lies ahead. We want to encourage you to continue giving to the ministry.
