AMENDED ORDER OF COUNTY JUDGE MARK J. KEOUGH
STAY HOME, STOP THE SPREAD

Whereas, On March 27, 2020 Montgomery County Judge Mark Keough issued a Stay at Home, Stop the Spread Order, that went into effect at 11:59 p.m. March 27, 2020 through 11:59 p.m. on April 12, 2020; and

Whereas, On March 29, 2020 President Donald J. Trump extended his executive order for social distancing through April 30, 2020; and

Whereas, On March 31, 2020 Governor Greg Abbott, signed Executive Order GA-14, extending the social distancing requirements for all Texas residents and adopting the 16 critical infrastructure sectors as identified by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and


Whereas, COVID-19 virus is contagious and spreads through person-to-person contact, especially in group settings; and

Whereas, given the ongoing evaluation of circumstances related to COVID-19 virus, the updated recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and the Texas Department of State Health Services, and the Montgomery County Public Health District, the substantial risk posed by COVID-19 virus to Montgomery County residents and their livelihoods, the following extraordinary measures must be taken to protect the public's safety.

NOW THEREFORE, I COUNTY JUDGE FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED BY TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 418, HEREBY FIND AND ORDER:

The Stay Home, Stop the Spread Order issued on March 27, 2020 is amended and extended and continues to be in effect until 11:59 p.m. on April 30, 2020.
