The Rindge Chamber of Commerce announces the 2019 **Rindge Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Award**. Under the Program, four (4) \$500 scholarships will be awarded to both 2 male and 2 female seniors attending Conant High School in Jaffrey, NH that reside in the town of Rindge, NH. Two of the scholarships will be awards to students who will go on to attend a 4-year program and two scholarships will be awarded to students who will go on to attend a 2-year program.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community/technical College or four (4)-year College or University.
- * Scholarship funds will be awarded at the senior recognition night at Franklin Pierce University held in June.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applications must be received by the Rindge Chamber of Commerce no later than **May 1, 2019**. Late applications will not be accepted.
