Contestants must be 16 years old or older and live in Logan County or an adjoin county (those under 18 must have parent’s signature). The number of entries is limited to two entries.

(Realize that we will be performing this for the public and children, so you should avoid explicit or suggestive language in your submissions...but should be positive in nature.)
