Electrical Requirements for Early, TX Showcase Vendors

All Vendors:

We will supply 120 Volt 20 Amp GFCI Protected receptacles to the vendors.

- You are responsible for your own cords and 3way adapters
- All cords must be outdoor rated


- All cords must be grounded (3 prongs)
- All cords must be a minimum of 16 Gauge
- All cords must be in good condition


No cuts No frayed wires No tape on the cords



- If you cannot plug your equipment into a standard receptacle, you will need to provide your own generator.
- Please understand that motors and heating elements may trip GFCI receptacles. We cannot bypass the GFCI under any circumstances.
