Helen C. Moore Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements

The Spencerport Area Chamber of Commerce will award a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating senior who resides in the towns of Ogden, South Parma (zip code of 14559) OR who is a student in the Spencerport Central School District and who plans to continue his or her education beyond high school with a major or minor in business. Candidates will be judged on the following:

- A. Scholastic Achievement
- B. Community Service
- C. Character
- D. Leadership
- E. Motivation

REQUIREMENTS

1. Students must reside in the towns of Ogden, South Parma (zip code of 14559) or be a student in the Spencerport Central School District.
2. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher at the end of the first semester in their senior year of high school.
3. Must have been accepted into a school of higher education with a major or minor in business.
4. Must submit the application cover page, letter of application, listing of community service activities, and a copy of the student's transcript through the first semester of their senior year on or before the application deadline.
5. Selected applicants will be scheduled to interview with the Spencerport Area Chamber of Commerce's scholarship selection committee.

The scholarship will be paid as follows:

- A. \$1,000 upon evidence of satisfactory completion (see B) of the first semester's work at a school of higher education beyond high school, with an assurance of registration for a second semester.

- B. The scholarship recipient must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better after completion of the first semester. The scholarship will be awarded within 30 days of receipt of the first semester transcript.

If the scholarship recipient's grade point average is less than 3.0 after their first semester, they may submit their cumulative transcript for their first two semesters. If the cumulative grade point average is 3.0 or higher, the scholarship will be awarded within 30 days of receipt of the two semester transcript. If the cumulative grade point average is less than 3.0 at the end of the first two semesters, the scholarship will not be awarded.

Additionally, an assurance of registration for a second year must be provided.

- a. Completed cover page
- b. Letter of application including:
 - a. an introduction of yourself, including interests and activities,
 - b. why you wish to attend college,
 - c. where you will be attending college and your major field of study,
 - d. why you are applying for the scholarship, and
 - e. why you are the applicant that should be selected for the scholarship.
- c. A copy of your high school transcript through the first semester of your senior year.
- d. A listing of your community service participation.

Selected candidates will be interviewed by a panel of members from the Board of Directors of the Spencerport Area Chamber of Commerce.
