St. Cloud Life – A Community & Business Extravaganza – First Saturday in March

St. Cloud's largest trade show features all businesses, agriculture and attractions including live entertainment, Beer & Wine Fest, Kids' Workshop and Taste of St. Clouds Finest Foods.

Annual Golf Classic – Second Friday in April

The annual golf tournament is one of the largest and the oldest in Osceola County. This is a major networking and socializing event that attracts decision makers in business and government.

4th of July – Lakefront Celebration

An old-fashioned 4th of July Celebration with plenty of good food, crafts, and entertainment; fun and games for the entire family. Topping the evening off is the best fireworks show in Osceola County!

Annual Awards Banquet – September

Join others for a fun-filled themed evening of great entertainment and fine dining. It includes awards recognition ceremony applauding those chamber members, businesses and community leaders, who have distinguished themselves through commitment, dedication, leadership and achievement.

Zombie Night Golf – Friday before Halloween October
