Reopening Adams County: Support for Small Businesses

COVID-19 Operations Mini Grant – Commissioner Mary Hodge

- Adams County Businesses with 1-25 Employees Are Eligible
- Grant Amount – \$2,500 per business (\$500k for a total of 200 businesses)
- Allowable Uses – Signage, Safety Equipment, Sneeze Guards, PPE...
- Application Process – Form Which Includes Rationale or Justification for Request
- Applicants Will Provide Impact Statement and Before and After Photos

Reopening Adams County: Support for Small Businesses

COVID-19 Technology Mini Grant – Commissioner Eva Henry

- Businesses with 1-25 Employees Closed or Impacted by COVID-19
- Grant Amount – \$1,000 per business (\$500k for a total of 500 businesses)
- Purpose – Update Technology to Promote New, Safer Operations
- Allowable Uses – Hardware, Software, Website Upgrades, Contactless Pay Systems
- Applicants Will Provide Impact Statement, Documentation, Before and After Photos

Reopening Adams County: Support for Small Businesses

COVID-19 Relief Loan – Commissioner Steve O’Dorisio

- Colorado Enterprise Fund Product for Businesses with Less Than 40 Employees
- Provide Bridge Capital to Larger Resources from Traditional Lenders or SBA
- Complement SBA Products – CEF Will Not Require SBA Applications
- Stand Alone For Full Term of Six Years or Less, Additional Support Mechanism
- Maximum Loan - \$25,000 with 3.5% Interest Rate

Reopening Adams County: Support for Small Businesses

Small Business Stabilization Program – Commissioner Emma Pinter

- Small Businesses (1-25 FTE) and Operating as of Feb. 12, 2019
- Must be Physical Establishment and Address in Adams County
- Businesses Must Document Loss of Revenue due to Public Health Orders
- Business Must Demonstrate How Grant Will Retain Jobs
- Applicants Who Were Unable to Secure Federal SBA Assistance
- First Come, First Serve Based on Need, Up to \$35,000 Maximum
