The Monterey Regional Waste Management District celebrated the installation of their new \$24 million materials recovery facility in Marina. The state-of-the-art recycling facility is the only one of its kind on the Central Coast. The new system will help Monterey County reach the state's goal of recovering 75 percent of its waste while lowering greenhouse gas emissions and providing green jobs in the community.
