Thank you for your interest in the Prescott Valley Festival of Lights Parade. Parade sign-in and staging will be at the Prescott Valley Event Center 4:30 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. No entries will be signed in after 5:45 p.m., so sign in early and enjoy the other festivities.

Parade Route: Parade starts at 6:00 p.m. or after the lighting of the Town Christmas Tree. This year's parade will be routed from Lakeshore to the Civic Center. A detailed map is attached.

Please complete the entry form and return to the Prescott Valley Chamber of Commerce. Deadline for entries is Monday, December 1st. There is a \$25.00 entry fee (no refunds). Parade will be held regardless of weather.

Rules: All entries must be lighted by a safe power source. No power will be provided. No Santa's will be allowed in the parade other than the one provided by the Chamber. No throwing, passing out, selling or distributing material of any kind before, during or after the parade. Keep all themes in good taste; the parade chairman has the right to pull a float that is distasteful. All floats must have a person on both sides walking on the ground to keep the crowd away from the float.

Tips for Lighting Your Parade Entry

The following information is supplied as possible suggestions for lighting your entry. This information is supplied only as a guide. The single most important consideration is to be aware of safety. If you have any questions about the safety of your lighting, please contact a qualified electrician for advice.

Lighting can be achieved in several fairly simple ways:

1. Portable gasoline powered generators. This is a simple way to provide lighting without complicate wiring. You can use regular Christmas lighting designed for house current.
2. Inverters. An inverter is a device that converts 12 Volt DC Current to 110 Volt AC (household current). This device can be easily connected to the vehicle's cigarette lighter or directly to the electrical system. Another option would be to carry a regular 12 Volt power source (an auto battery for example) directly on your entry. Inverters are available locally at Radio Shack as well as most auto parts stores. You will need to match the capacity of the inverter to the total watts needed to operate the lights on your entry.
3. Standard battery operated devices. This is probably the easiest way to provide lighting for your entry.
