In the last few weeks there have been questions around the operation of the Baker County Chamber of Commerce and the Baker County Visitor Center. We hope the following information clears up any confusion.

The parent corporation for the Chamber of Commerce is Baker County Unlimited, for the purposes of simplicity we often refer to ourselves as BCU. Under the BCU umbrella you'll find both the Baker County Chamber of Commerce and the Baker County Visitor Center. This model has been in place for a number of years and has worked quite successfully.

We've heard some folks state that they believe it to be an inherent conflict for the Chamber of Commerce to operate the Visitor Center and for one director to oversee both. We actually believe the opposite to be true. We believe that our knowledge of county businesses is an asset to not only Baker County business owners, but to our visitors as well.

We are custodians of regional stories. Our staff knows the people stories including early settlers, historic figures and living icons. We know place stories about the local geography, Baker County history and our heritage. Because of our close relationships with businesses across the county we know the produce stories and talk about the local industries, food, wine, beverages and art. Visitors need to know where they can find fuel, restaurants and even mechanics if the need arises – we know that information and share it with them!

We understand the reality of our location. We know that many visitors will find the information and inspiration they need for Baker County without ever stepping into the visitor center. We also understand that our high traffic location is what lends to our success even in the age of electronics and social media.

The good news is this discussion has prompted us to reach out to the other Chambers of Commerce across the state of Oregon and we are happy to report that over 85% of the Chambers are ALSO the Visitor Center. Everyone in the industry agrees, combining the efforts of the Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Services not only makes sense, but it's an exceptional way to host visitors and support businesses.
