- * Participated in an athletic program during the 12th grade

Selection Process: Submit the following.

- APPLICATION
- LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FROM A COACH
- ESSAY (Coach Influence) see last page
- TRANSCRIPT and/or ACT SCORES

Applications will be rated independently by a panel selected from the Grant County Chamber Board of Directors.

Students will be rated on a 100 point basis:

5-10 points for GPA
1-10 points for letter of recommendation
1-50 points for essay
1-10 honors / awards / activities
1-20 athletic involvement
