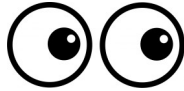


More To See & Do



Walking Trails

- ⇒ Follow our “*Camrose Urban Park System*” Map. This can be found at the Camrose Visitor Information Centre, or online in PDF format at www.camrose.ca
- ⇒ Camrose has approximately 21 km of paved, interconnected walking trails.
- ⇒ There are also great picnic areas on the trails such as those at Jubilee Park and Mirror Lake Park.

- ⇒ 60’ depth for scuba divers
- ⇒ Designated swimming areas
- ⇒ Non-motorized boating

Directions: East on Highway 13, South on Highway 56, East on TWP Road 452 (Heather Brae Hall Road), Continue East for 8 km, pass over the tracks, Immediately on the left hand side.
