Tickets will be available at the gate on the day of the event for \$30 for adults and \$15 for children 6-10. There is no charge for children five and under.

This year the Hub City BBQ Cook-off is proving to be the biggest one yet! There are close to 100 cooking teams ready to claim bragging rights on the best BBQ on the South Plains.

Held in downtown Lubbock on Broadway between Avenues Q and M, and just west of the Wells Fargo Center between Main Street and Broadway Avenue, over 7,000 members of the South Plains community will sample some of the best BBQ around.

This year's entertainment will be headlined by popular Texas Country music artist, Zane Williams, while the opening will be provided by the School of Rock, with local musicians playing some good ol' rock and roll.
