We use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server, and to administer our web site. Your IP address is used to help identify you and your shopping cart and to gather broad demographic information.

Our site's registration form requires users to give us contact information (like their name and e-mail address), unique identifiers (like their member identification number), and financial information (like their account or credit card numbers). The customer's contact information is used to contact the visitor when necessary and shared with other companies who may want to contact our visitors. Users may opt-out of receiving future mailings; see the choice/opt-out section below. Financial information that is collected is used to check the users' qualifications for registration and to bill the user for products and services. Unique identifiers (such as the member identification number) are collected to verify the user's identity and for use as account numbers in our record system.

Our site uses an order form for customers to request information, products, and services.
