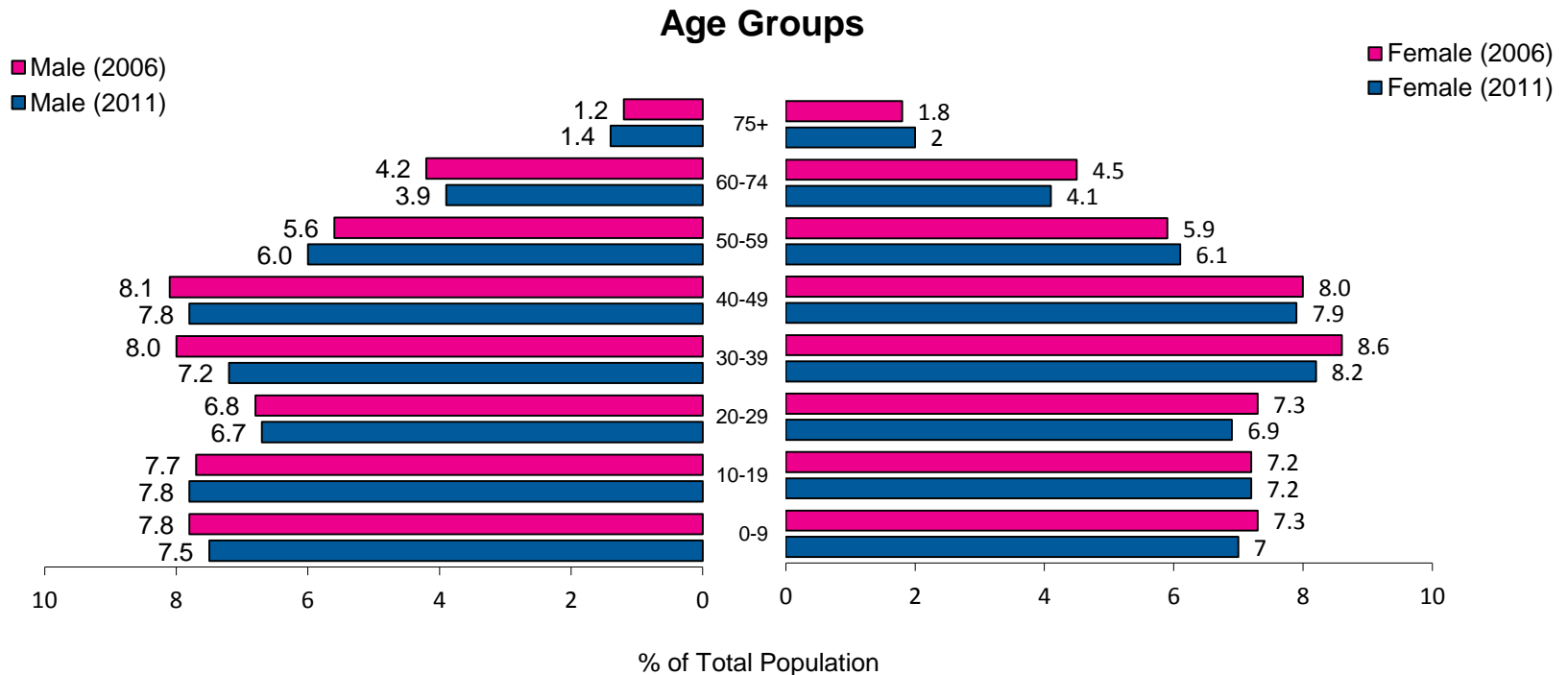


City of Brampton Labour and Workforce Overview

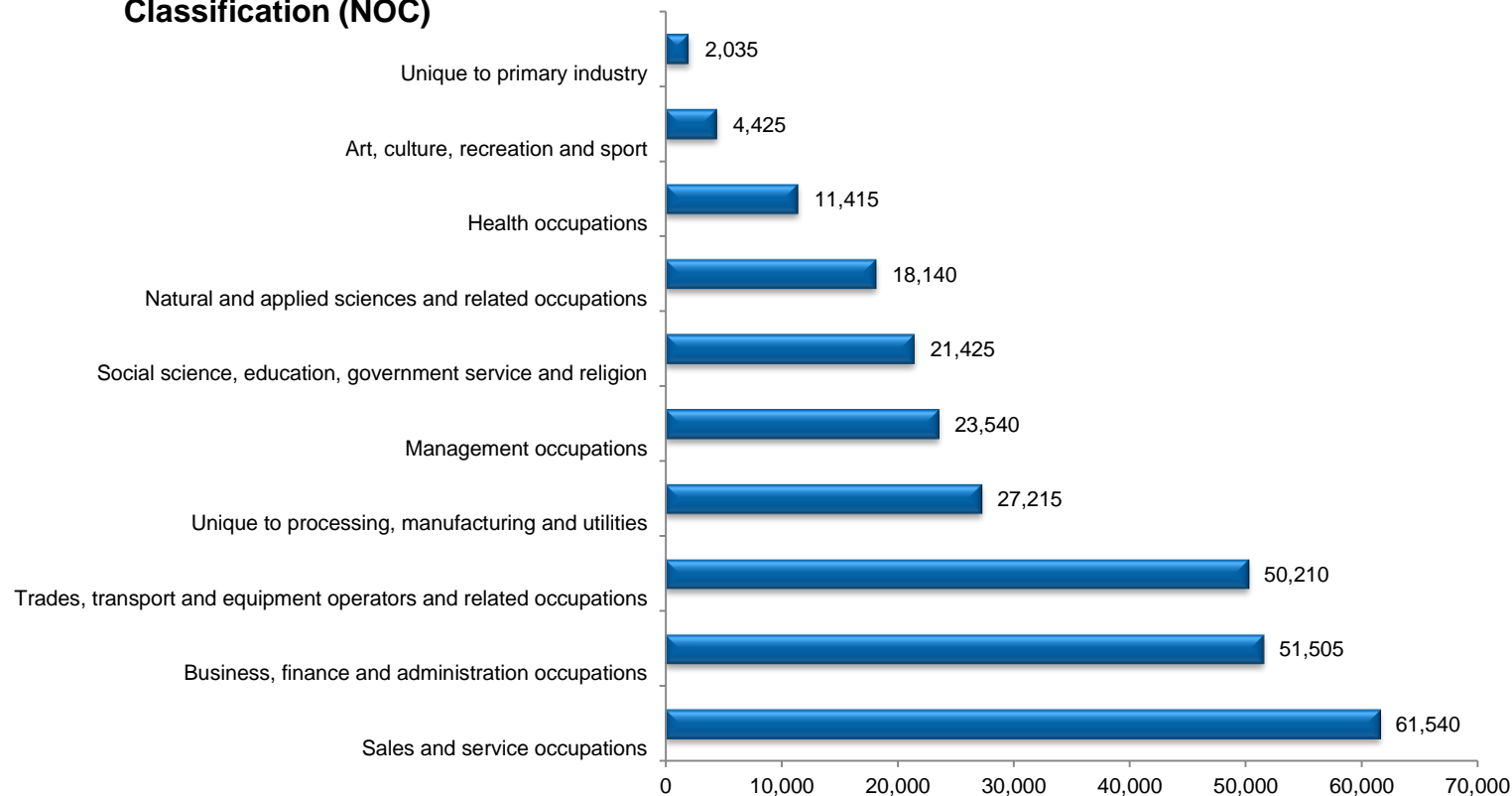
A Young & Growing Labour Pool

National Occupational Classification (NOC)



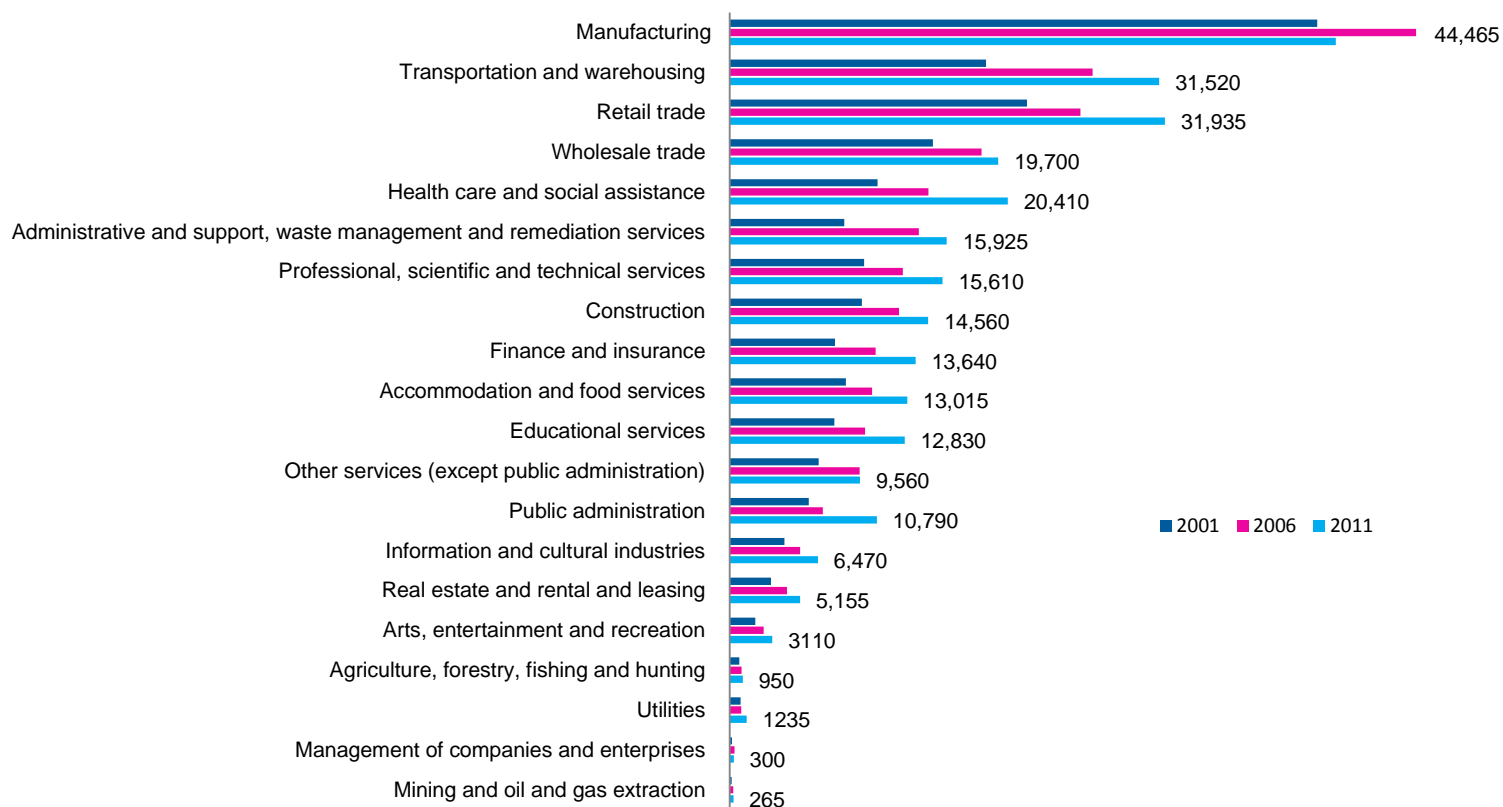
Labour Force by Industry

 Manufacturing remained the largest industry for Brampton Labour Force*

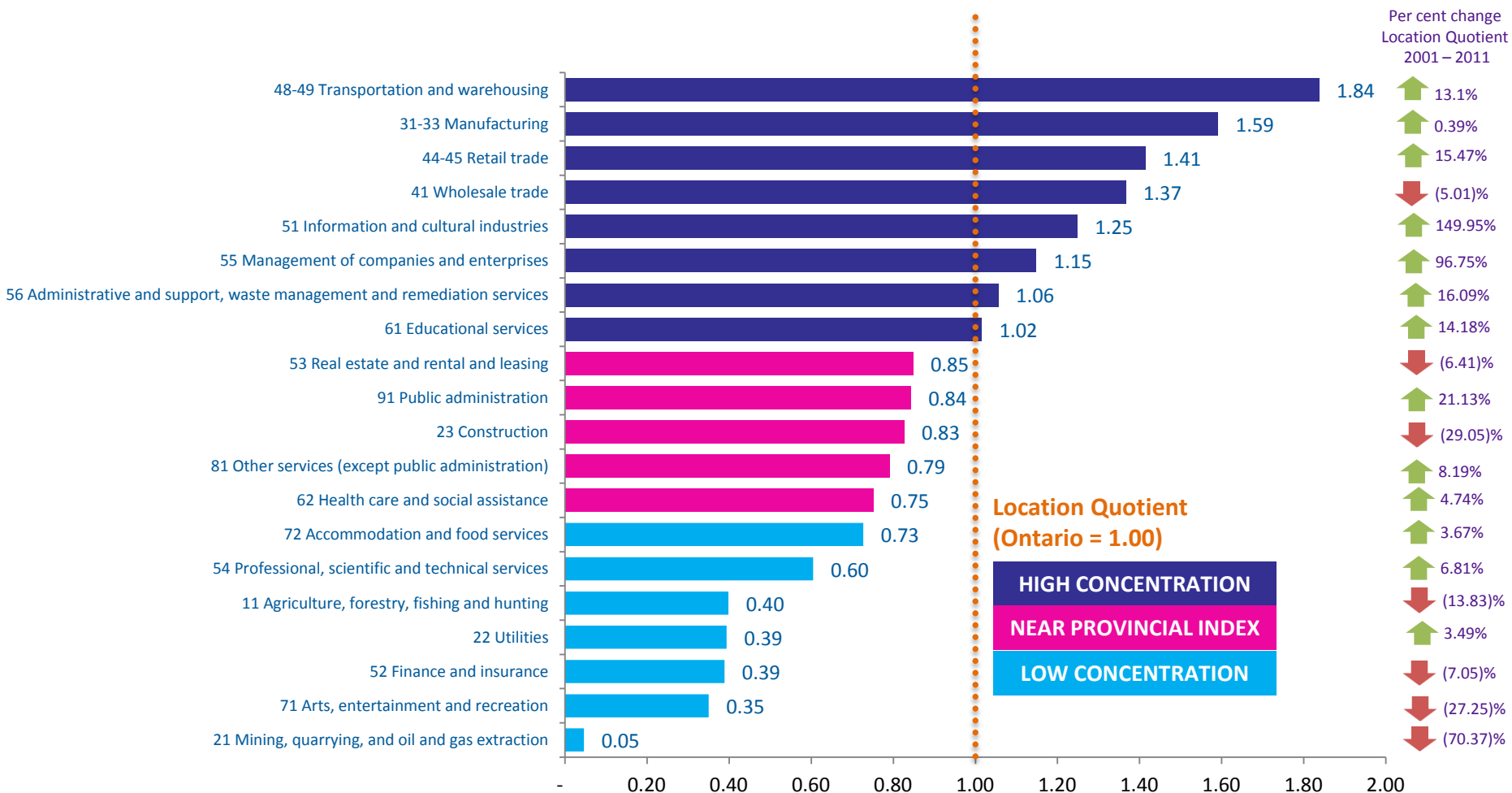

Labour Force by Industry (2001 -2011)

Between 2001 and 2011, the Brampton labour force by Industry increased by 87,185 workers. The 2011 NHS also revealed that Manufacturing, Transportation and Warehousing and Retail Trade continued to be the three largest industries based on employment and account for 39.8 per cent of total labour force by Industry.



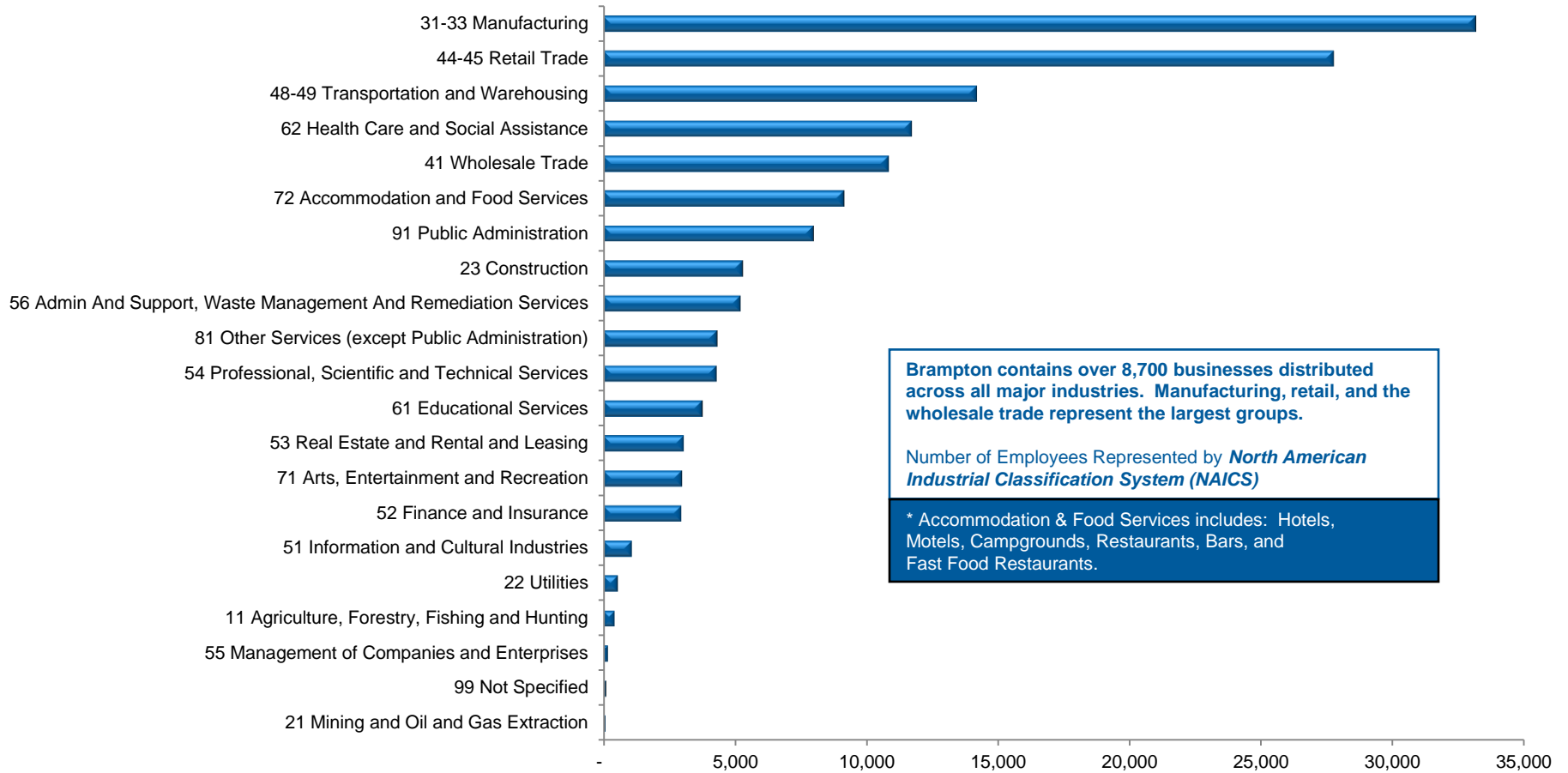
Economic Base Analysis - Brampton in Relation to Ontario

A Well Balanced Economy



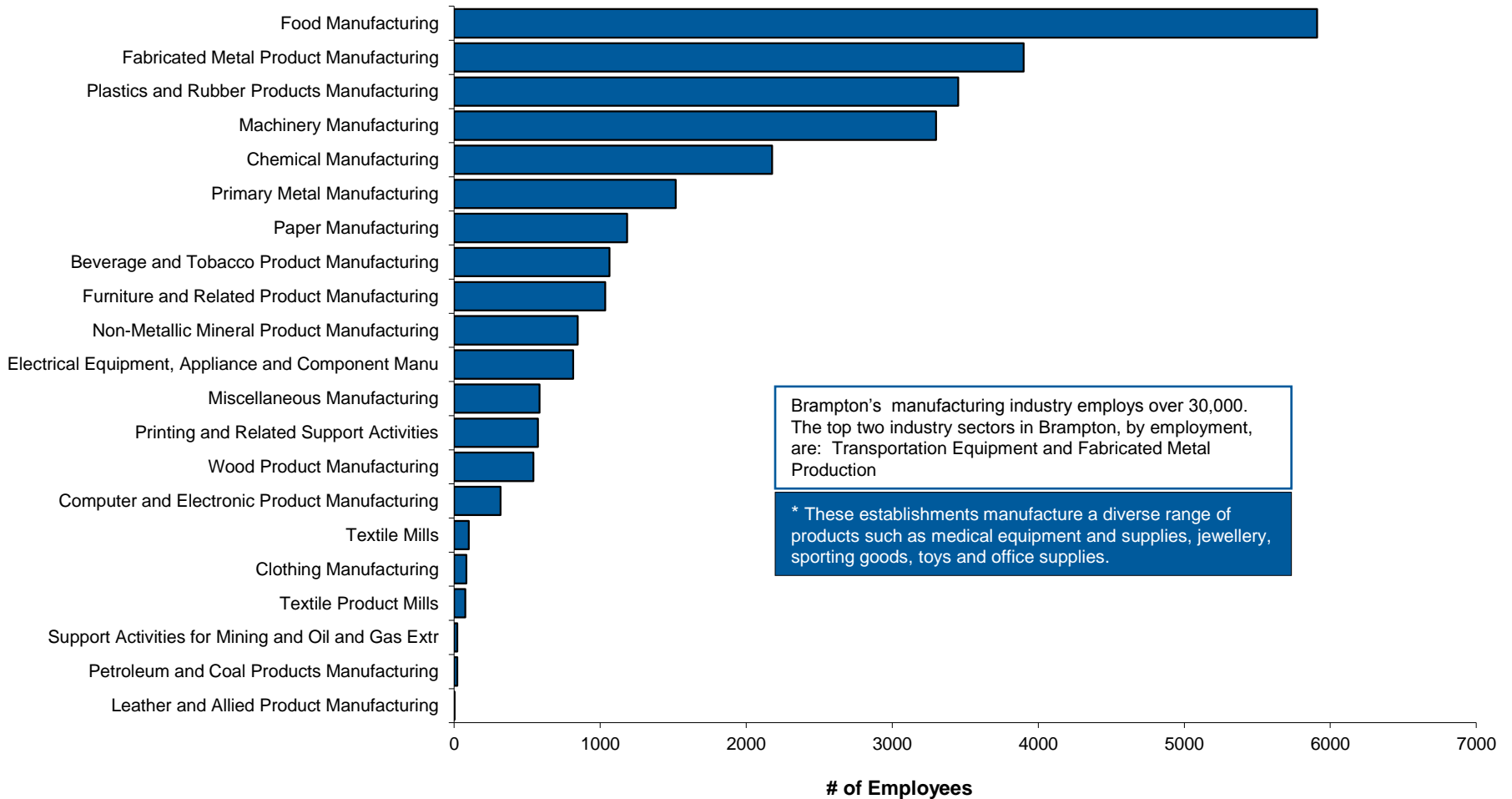
Brampton contains over 8,700 businesses distributed across all major industries. Manufacturing, retail, and the wholesale trade represent the largest groups.

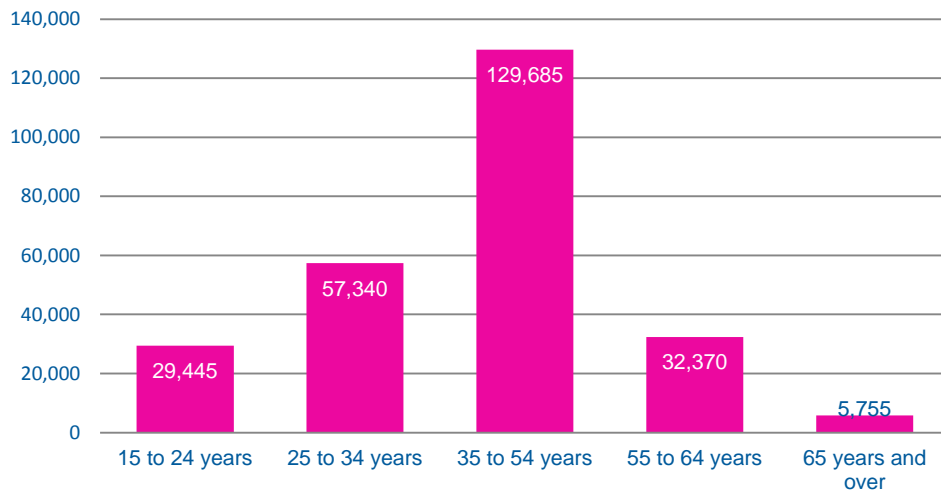

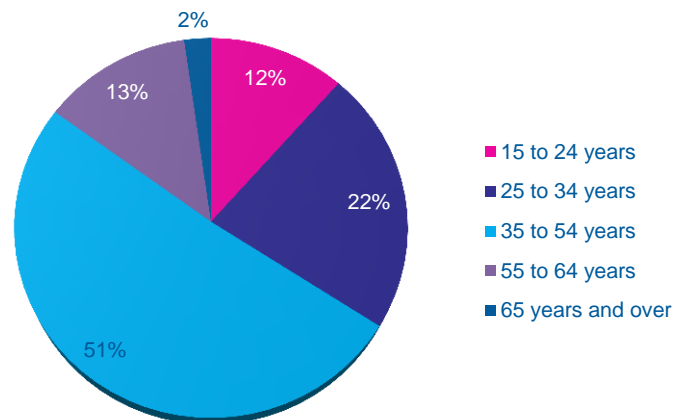

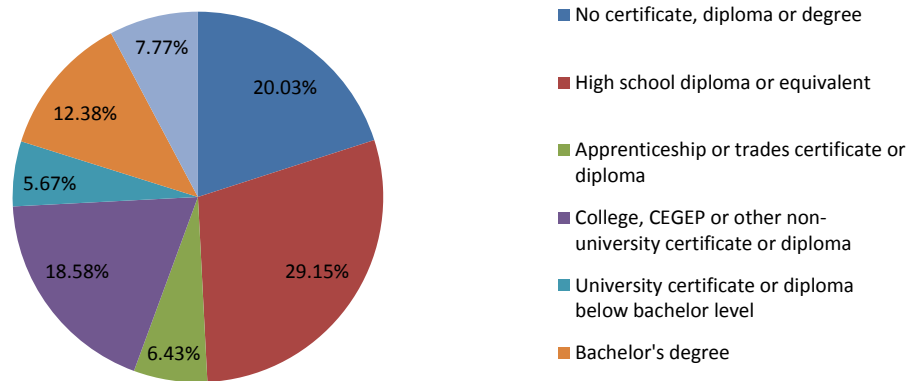
