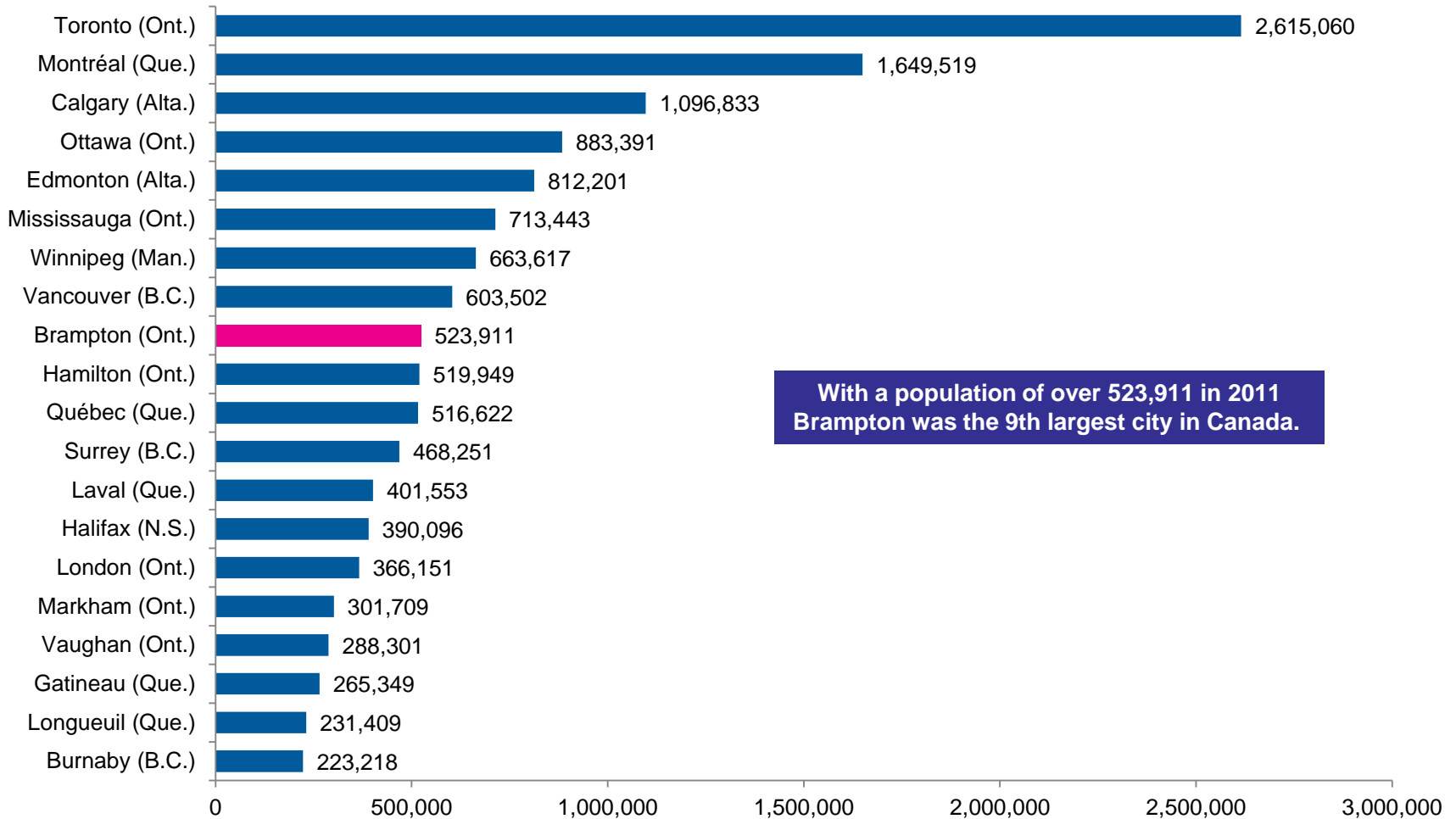
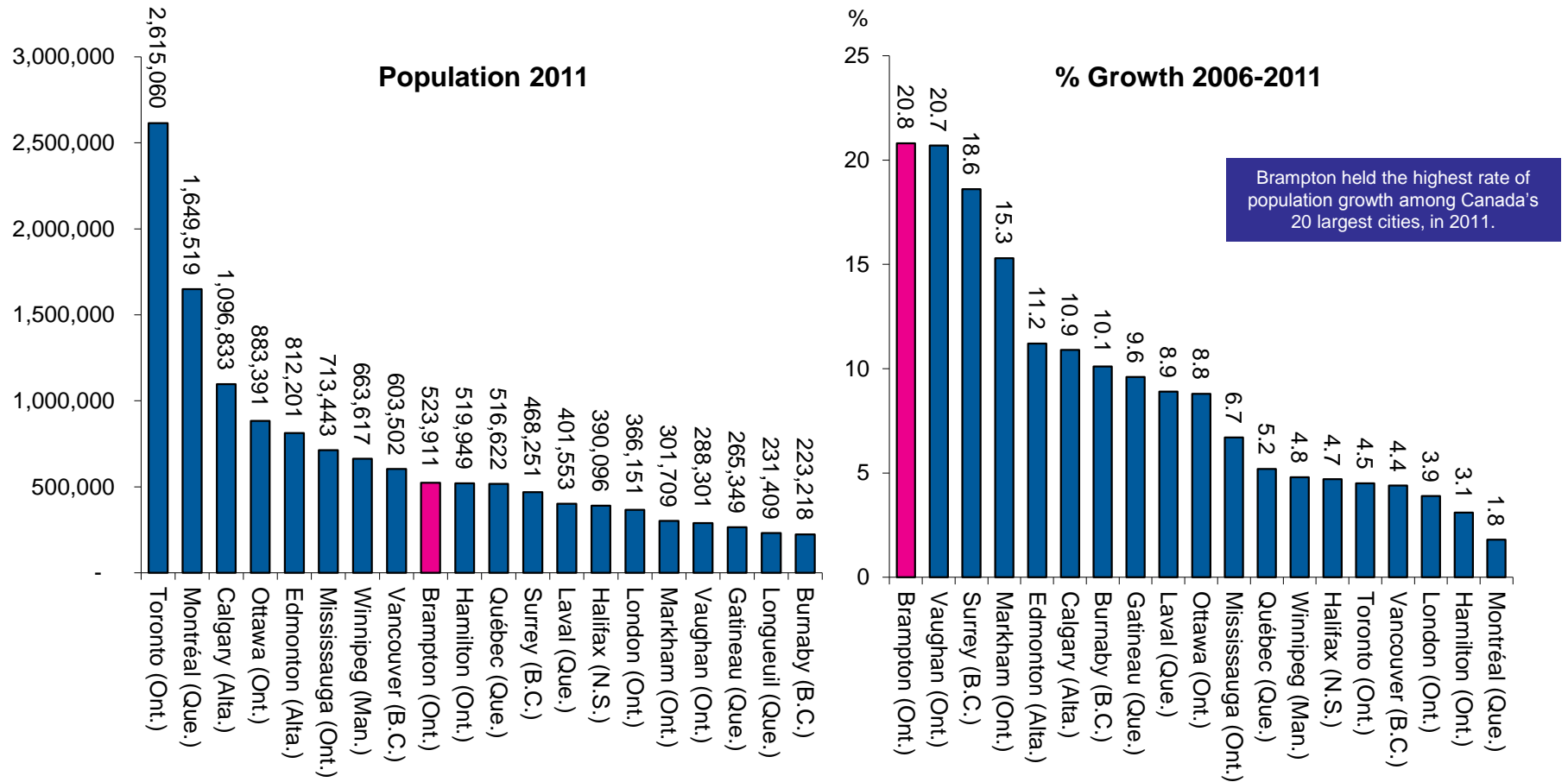

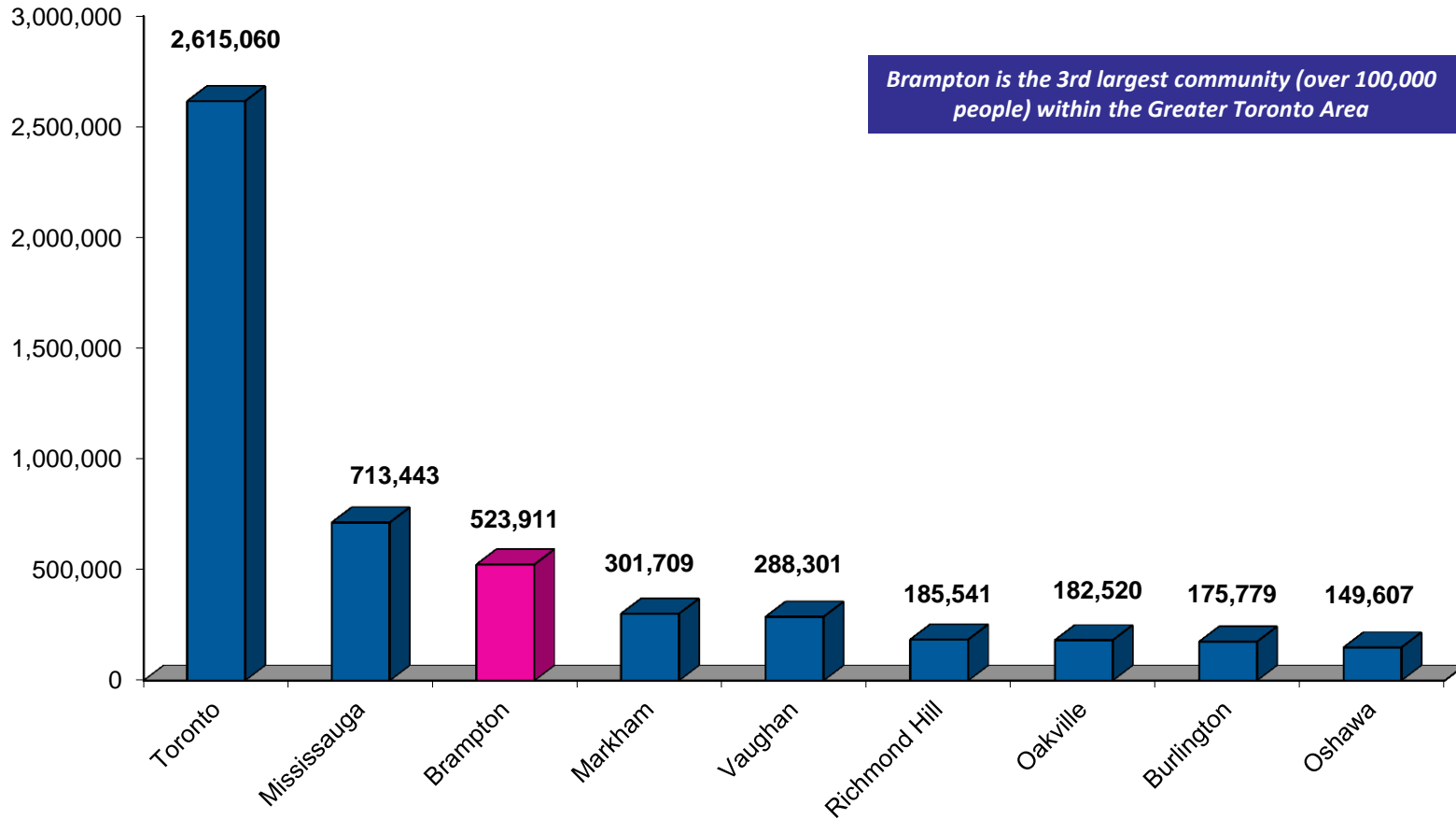
Brampton Among Canada's 20 Largest Municipalities



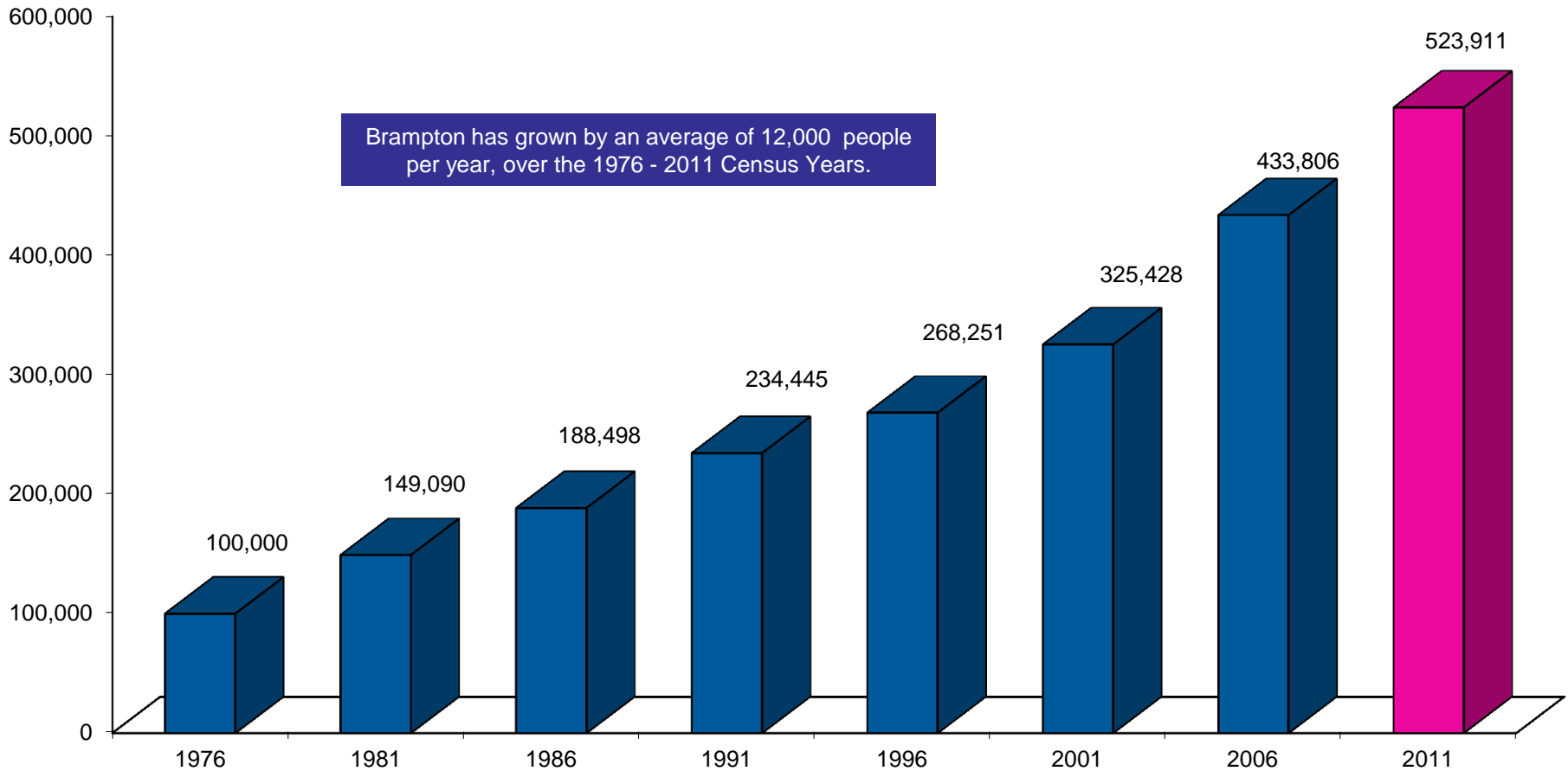
Among Canada's Fastest Growing Places



Brampton and the GTA Population Comparisons, 2011



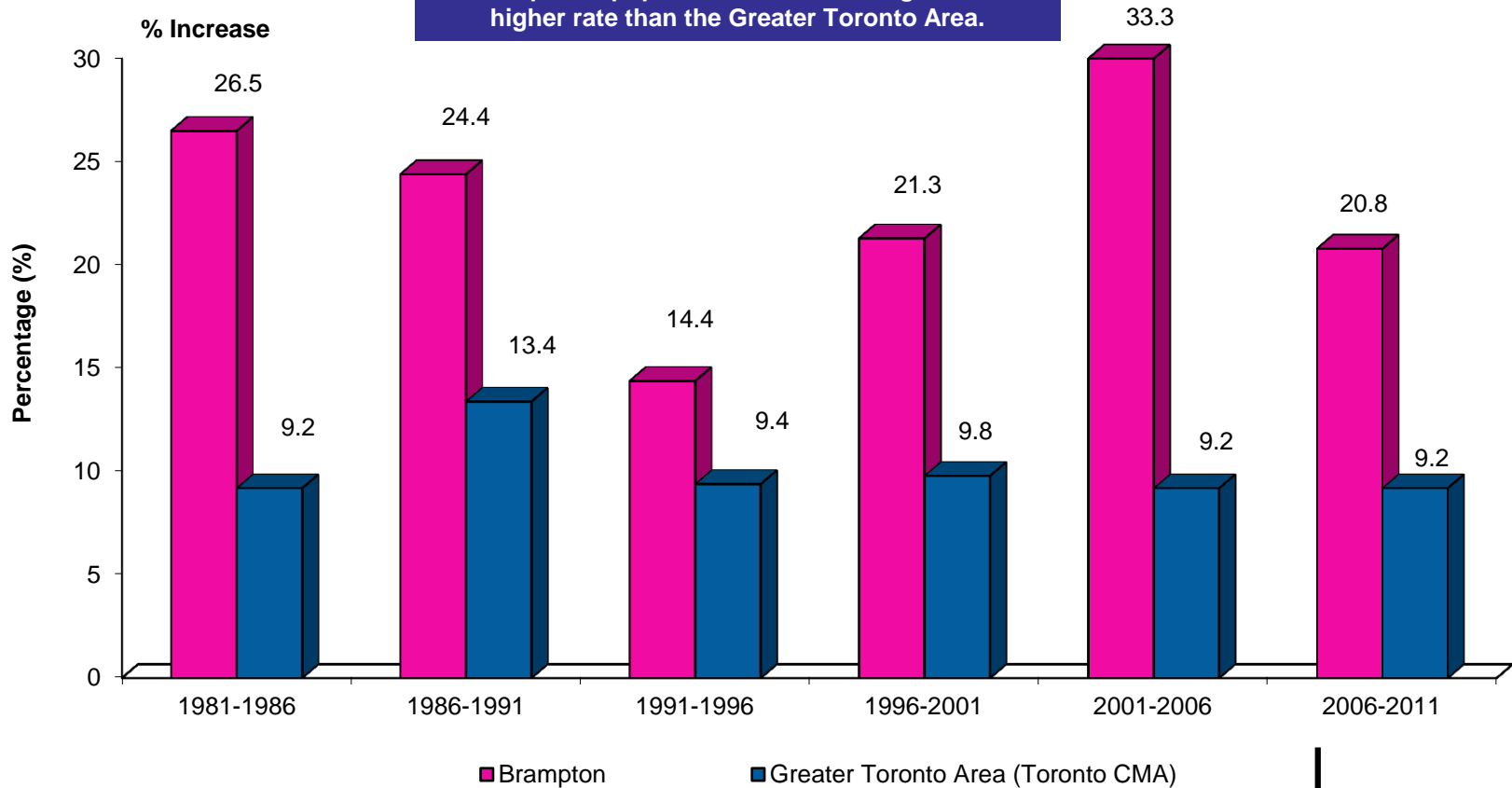
Historic Population Growth 1976-2011



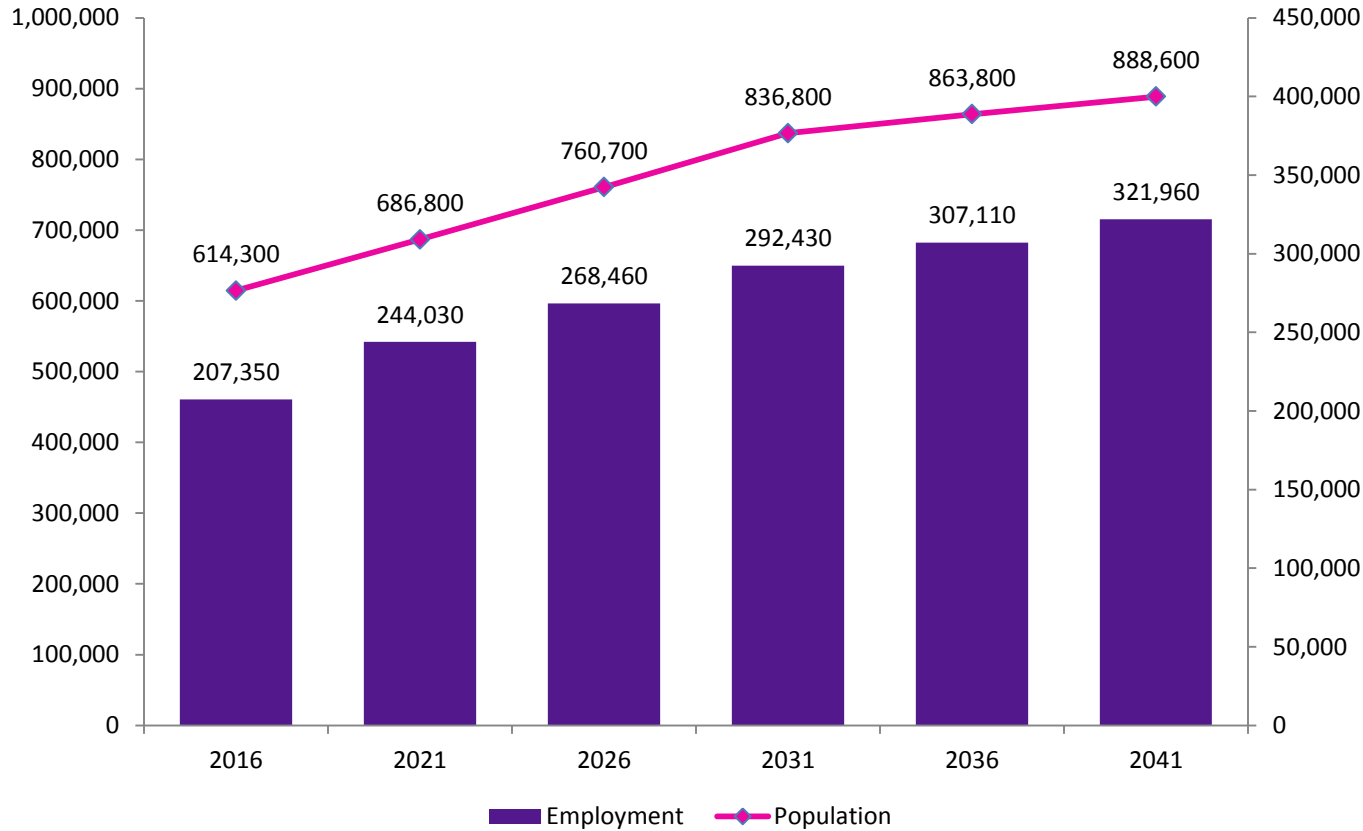

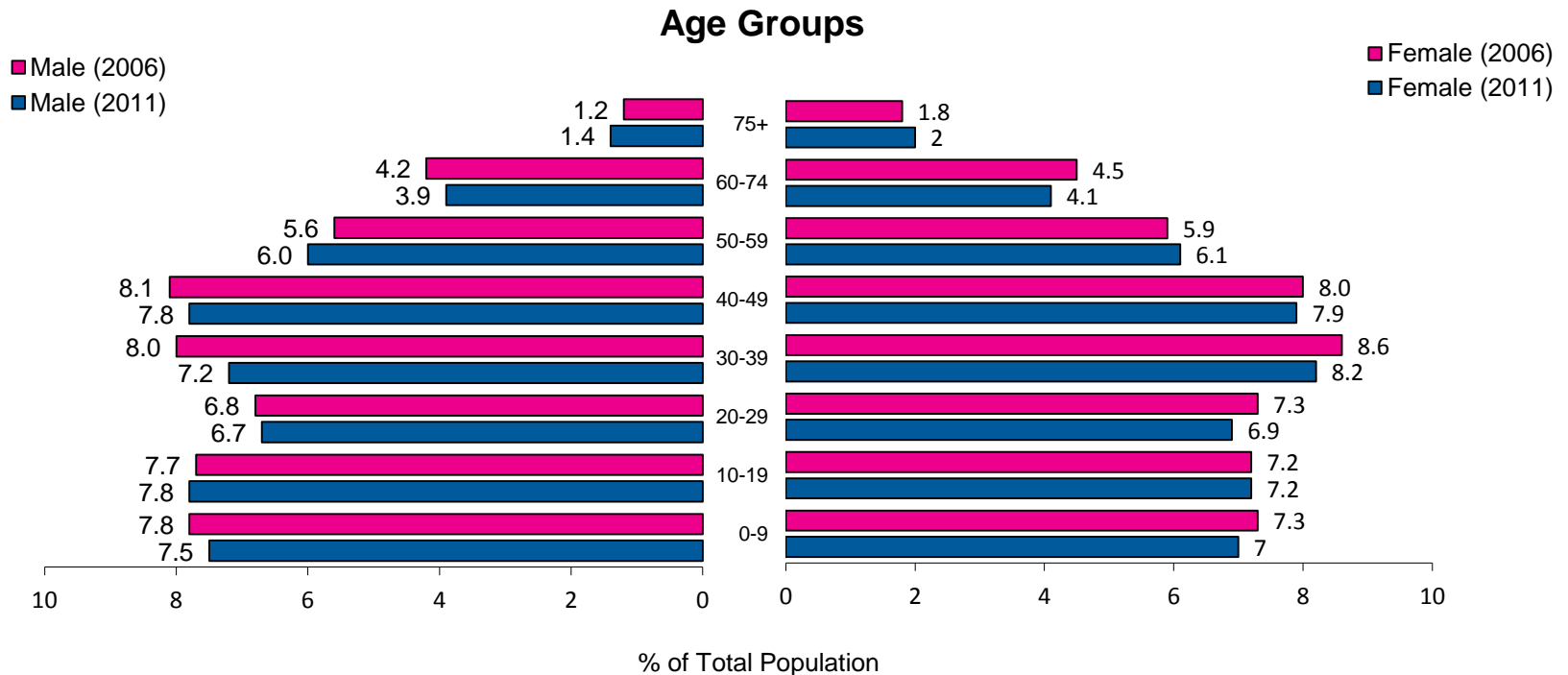

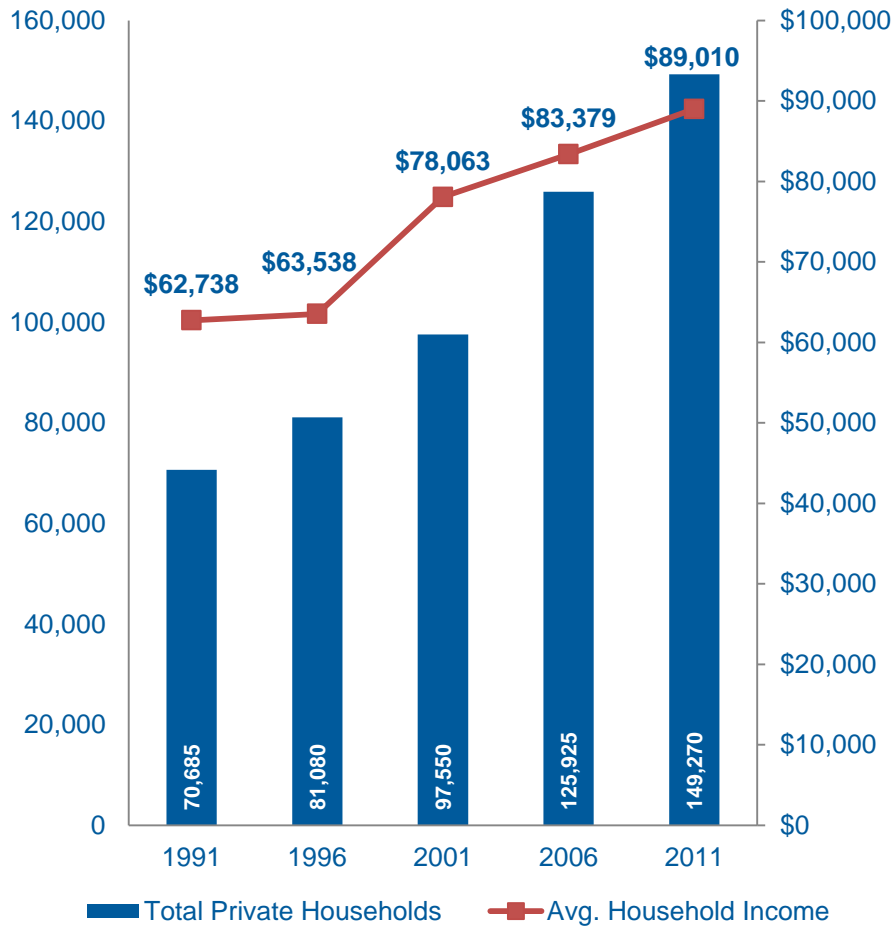

A Young & Growing Labour Pool

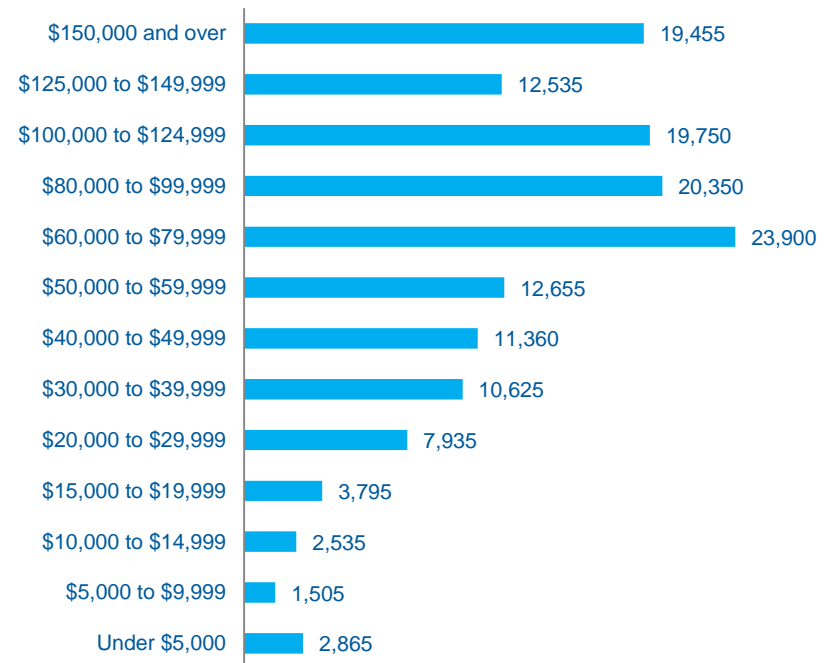
Brampton's largest population cluster is 30-49 years of age. Positive prospects for a sustained labour force in the future are reassured by the 1-19 age groups.



Total Private Households and Average Household Income



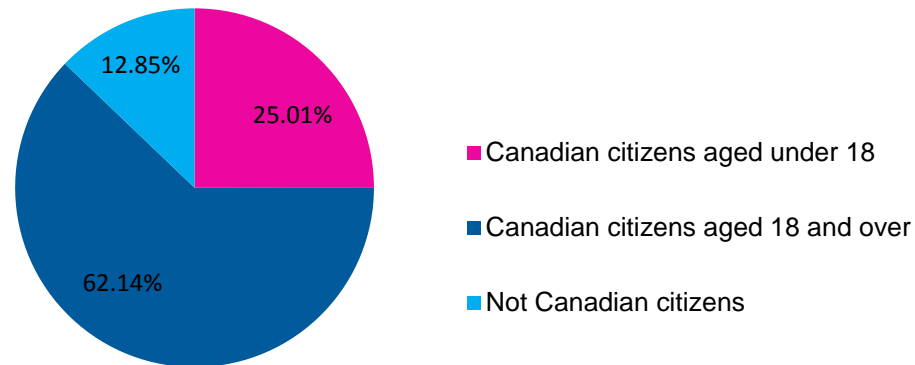
Household total income in 2010 of private households



Brampton's Immigrant Population

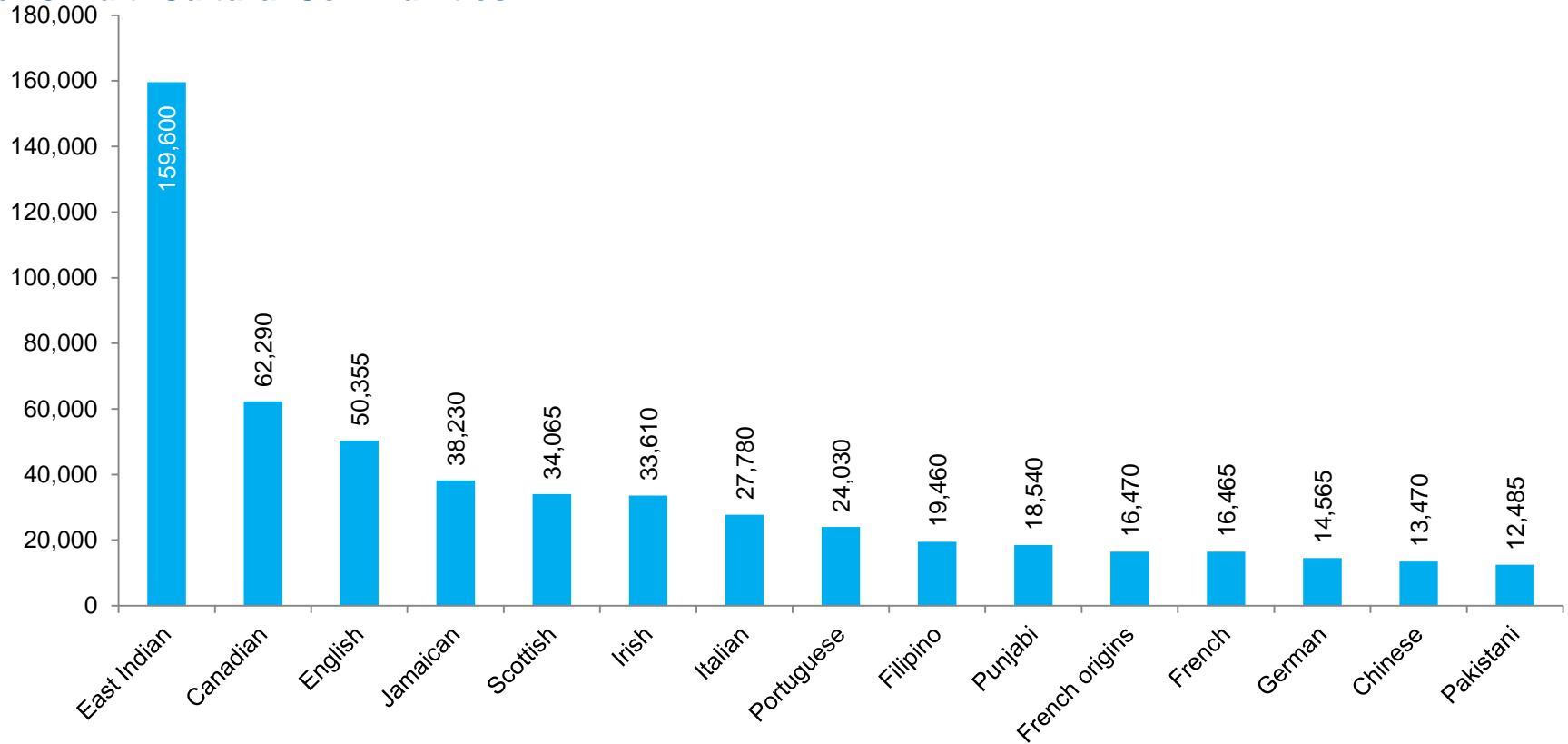
Like many North American cities, immigrant population in Brampton continues to play an important role the growth and development of the community.

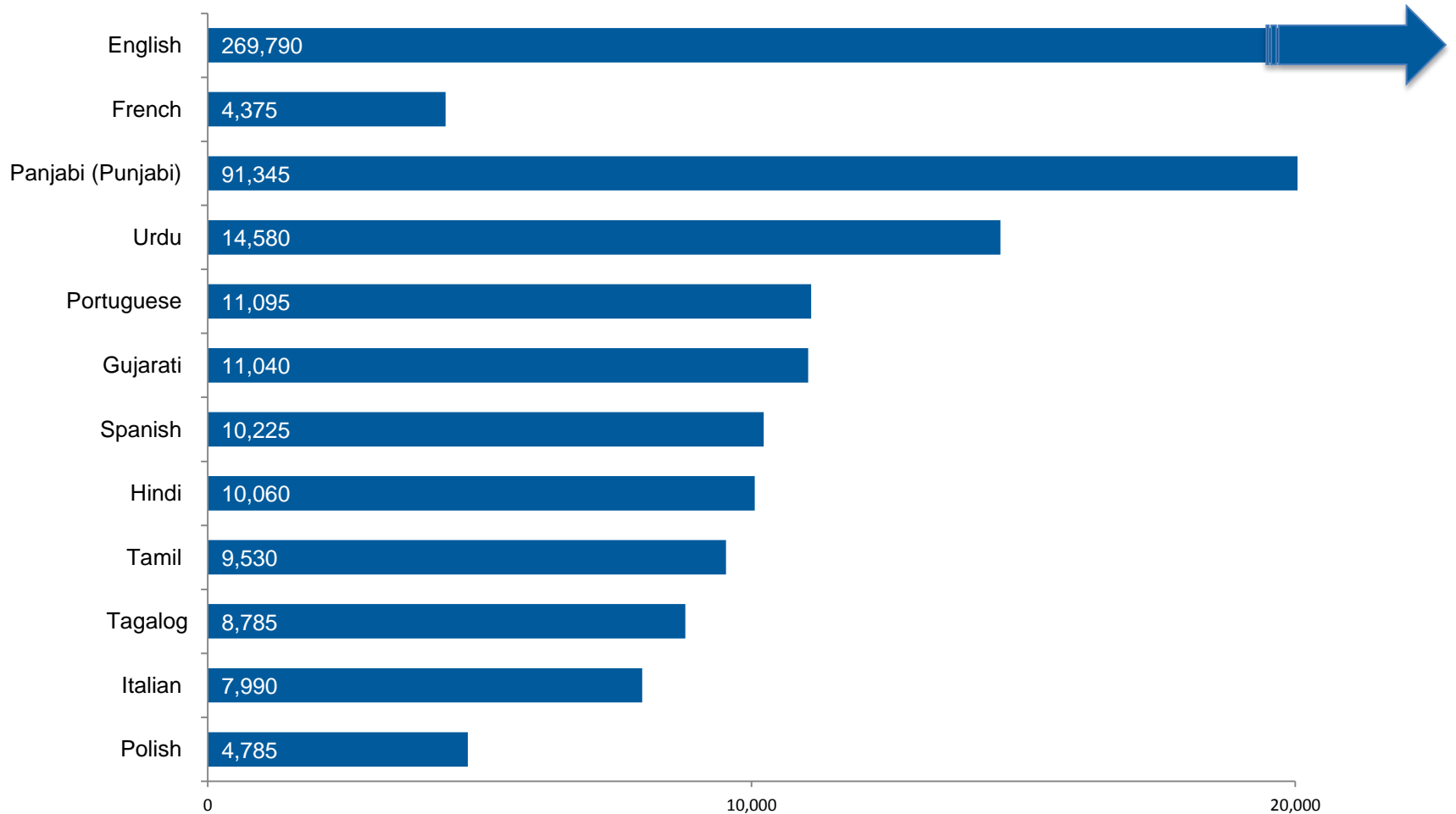
Brampton's Ethnic Composition
