Examples of sessions:

Introduction and Team Building: Team Building activities may include *True Colors*, a low-ropes course, educational speaker, class project or other activities to uniquely unite each class.

Healthcare: Tours/discussions with Missouri Delta Medical Center, Ferguson Medical Group, and Kenny Rogers Children's Center.

Hometown Heroes: This is a new session for the class of 2018 where they will have the opportunity to talk directly with a variety of community leaders, including business owners, past city officials and others who have been essential to our community.

Agriculture and Agri-Business: Tours include Monsanto, Pioneer, New Madrid Port Authority, and often ends with a celebration at a local winery.
