Classes can have a maximum of 20 trainees per class (including those that are eligible for funding and those that are not).

Employees must be California employees to be eligible.

An employee must be working at least 35 hours per week to be eligible.

90 days after the end of training, employees must make a minimum hourly wage to be eligible. The minimums for Southern California counties are as follows:

Los Angeles \$16.48, Orange \$16.51, San Diego \$16.46, other Southern California Counties \$15.60. The employer's cost of the health benefits an employee actually takes advantage of can be broken down to a cost per hour worked and also be used to meet the minimum requirement.

In order to receive funding for an employee, the employee must still be employed by the company 90 days after the end of the training.

Social security numbers must be provided for eligible employees so the state can verify wages and hours in the Employment Development Department's system.
