- All contestants **MUST** keep their Social Media accounts free from any and all profanity, indecent exposures, slander, or any other disgraceful behavior.
- **ANY** and **ALL** Photos, Videos, Posts, etc that displays indecency in any way, should be taken down.
- Please do not post any photos that contain any footage or details from our Miss Woodstock Rehearsals or from Pageant Day. You may post as many tasteful photos as you would like from your journey **AFTER** June 2nd, 2018.
- Use social media to your advantage in a positive manner. If any contestant is found to be slandering the Miss Woodstock Organization, or any of its affiliates including fellow contestants, that said contestant will be disqualified from entering the pageant indefinitely in future years.
- If there is an inappropriate photo, post, video, etc that deems as indecent, please contact Pageant Directors as soon as possible.
- The Miss Woodstock Organization has a **ZERO TOLERANCE** for cyber bullying. If at any time during the course of the pageant journey a contestant **OR** Miss Woodstock 2018 is to have violated our social media rules and regulations, she will be disqualified and de-crowned.
