TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1-2: 8 – 9 APR VANCOUVER DEPARTURE

Today make your own way to the airport to depart on your overnight flight to South Africa. Enjoy in-flight meals and services. Overnight on board the flight

DAY 3: 10 APR JOHANNESBURG (ARRIVAL) – SUN CITY

Upon arrival in Johannesburg, you will be met and transferred to Sun City, internationally renowned as Africa's premier holiday resort. The fabulous resort complex captivates visitors with its combination of world class restaurants, casinos, golf, entertainment centre and game safari. The resort is buzzing with activity any time of the day. Day at leisure to explore this wonderful complex on your own. Overnight at Sun City

DAY 4: 11 APR SUN CITY - PILANESBERG NATIONAL PARK – SUN CITY (B/-/-)

Embark on a **3 hour morning and an optional 3 hour afternoon safari drive** in the unspoilt beauty of the Pilanesberg National Park. Encounter Africa's Big Five and many other natural inhabitants at close range. Drive back to Sun City after and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at Sun City

DAY 5: 12 APR SUN CITY - PILANESBERG NATIONAL PARK – SUN CITY (B/-/-)

Embark on a **3-hour morning safari drive** in the unspoiled beauty of the Pilanesberg National Park. Encounter Africa's Big Five and many other natural inhabitants at close range. Drive back to Sun City after and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at Sun City

DAY 6: 13 APR SUN CITY (B/-/-)

Enjoy your day at leisure and enjoy the many amenities and activities available at Sun City. Overnight at Sun City

Optional: Hot Air Balloon Safari: CAD 585 per person

Experience Africa from above on a balloon flight over the sunny plains of the Pilanesberg National Park near Sun City. A balloon flight will allow you to hover over the savannah as you seek out lions, giraffes and hundreds of other creatures in this bountiful ecosystem from a unique aerial perspective. The unique vantage point provided by a balloon flight will allow you to see things normal tours might miss, as well as allowing you to soak in the stunning landscape from a totally new perspective. Upon landing, sip on champagne as you compare unforgettable sights with your fellow travellers

Optional: Bush Walk (Min of 4 pax): CAD 104 per person

You'll see the sunny African wilds on foot in the Pilanesberg National Park near Sun City. This bush walk will see you traversing the sunny plains, eyes peeled for members of the park's vibrant wildlife. Elephants, lions and rhinos are supplemented by dozens of species of buck and colourful bird life. Your guide will also help you to appreciate the plant life all during your bush walk. Expect to see a number of indigenous trees during this bush walk and learn all about the complex ecosystem of this famed safari destination as you get up close and personal with interesting flora and fauna alike.

DAY 7: 14 APR SUN CITY (B/-/-)

Enjoy your day at leisure and enjoy the many amenities and activities available at Sun City. Overnight at Sun City

Optional: Quad Biking: CAD 104 per person

Let the dirt spray as you indulge in a quad biking adventure around the African bush near Sun City. Instructors will help you get to grips with it, even if you are a beginner, before guiding you into the wild. Soon the African air will be whipping through your hair as you scoot over the dust. The area's quad biking adventures offer options for all skill levels as you roar across the plains. There are few more visually arresting quad biking adventure destinations, meaning that what happens off the track is just as incredible as what happens on it. Expect your adrenaline to be pumping. Departure from Welcome Centre or Activity Hub.

Optional: Leeto-Kgolo Village Tour (Min of 4 pax): CAD 117 per person

Explore the rich and dynamic history of Bakgatla-Ba-Kgafela tribe, the people of Pilanesberg. This exciting tour takes you to four Bakgatla heritage sites combined with a travel through the village on bicycles. The route has some off-road experience and mountainous tar road and includes stops at the cemetery of the first missionaries to arrive in Moruleng in the 1800's, a stop at Kgosi Kgamanyane's wall, a local shebeen/tuck shop for some refreshments and interaction with the locals, the first non-missionary school, the rain making rock. Followed with a stop at "Tshilong" where guests will get a traditional beer welcome drink and learn about traditional food preparations and get hands on involved in the process. Afterwards the tour will end at TT's for traditional pap, veggies, meat and a soft drink before heading back to Sun City.

DAY 8: 15 APR SUN CITY - CAPE TOWN (B/-/-)

After a delicious breakfast, check out of your hotel and hop onto your transfer back to OR Tambo International Airport for your onward flight to Cape Town. Upon arrival in Cape Town, you will be transferred to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure to explore on your own. Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 9: 16 APR CAPE TOWN (B/-/-)

Enjoy the **Robben Island tour**: Board your boat cruise from the Waterfront to the famous Robben Island – a cruel home of our Nelson Mandela for so many years, it's a highly charged and emotional moment when you visit the site of this suffering and realize how far South Africa has come from those days. For nearly 400 years, Robben Island, about 12 kilometres from Cape Town, was a place of exile and imprisonment where rulers sent those they regarded as outcasts and troublemakers. Since 1997 Robben Island has been a museum acting as a focal point of South African heritage.

DAY 10: 17 APR CAPE TOWN (B/-/-)

Full Day Cape Winelands Tour: A superb day dedicated to celebrating the glorious grape, the exceptional winelands region, and the heavenly scenery! The area's rich with history, and we can't help but feel it as we move through the region to experience a wine cellar tour and tasting, where you'll learn all about the process of winemaking, from grape to goblet. We visit the exquisite little town of Franschhoek, pass by the impressive Huguenot Monument, and in a town with a reputation for gourmet fare, where else could we choose to enjoy lunch. Wind our way to the heady heights of the Helshoogte Mountain Pass to meet the charming university town of Stellenbosch on the other side. Stroll through this little town, absorbing the quaintness, and sneaking into the odd shop or two (on Sundays not all galleries and shops are open)! Enjoy a wine tasting at two different wine estates where you'll be able to purchase your favourite wine to take back home!

DAY 11: 18 APR CAPE TOWN (B/-/-)

Spend your day at leisure or enjoy the optional tour of your choice

Optional: Cape Town Helicopter Experience: CAD 155 per person

Enjoy an exciting 12-minute flight that will take you over the mother city for a bird's eye view of the Cape Town stadium, Lions Head, the white beaches of Clifton, Camps Bay and the majestic twelve apostles.

Optional: Table Mountain Cable Car (ticket only, weather permitting): CAD 53 per person

Go up the majestic Table Mountain where you will be able to see the entire vista of Cape Town and the surrounding views of the southernmost tip of Africa.

Optional: Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour: CAD 137 per person

Sit back and relax, we're going to drive along the exquisite stretch of coastline known as the Millionaire's Paradise – from Camps Bay and Clifton to the exclusive beach of Llandudno – towards the charming working harbour of Hout Bay. Back on Terra Firma, we wind along the legendary Chapman's Peak Drive, hugging the cliffs and relishing the breathtaking ocean views, before arriving at the wild and beautiful Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve an integral part of the world renowned Cape Floral Kingdom. We meander back along the coast towards the city, visiting the historic naval port of Simon's Town and enduring penguin colony (entrance not included) at Boulder's Beach. The Fairest Cape of All, that was Sir Francis Drake's opinion...and we're sure you'll echo it!

DAY 12: 19 APR CAPE TOWN - VANCOUVER (B/-/-)

Transfer to the airport to board your flight to Canada.
