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Rules and Regulations

- 1.** This community BBQ competition is limited to 16 teams. It is a first come first serve. There will be 5 Categories in this contest; Chicken, Ribs, Pork, Brisket and People's Choice.
- 2.** ALL CATEGORIES WILL BE JUDGED BY TASTE, TENDERNESS AND APPEARANCE!
- 3.** All cookers must set up on April 20th between 8am and 5pm. Meat Inspections will also be April 20th between 8am-5pm. There will be a Mandatory Cook`s Meeting at 5pm the same day as set up.
- 4.** Teams may cook with any type of wood and/or Charcoal and propane. Flammables may be used outside and away from the cooker to make additional coals to help keep meat warm.
- 5.** Each Team must prepare enough pulled pork for 500 1-ounce samples. Each team must supply ALL of their meat, cooking ingredient's, individual cooking devices, utensils, and preparation tables. All cooking devices must clear the ground by a minimum of 6" between bottom and ground. Grease must be caught in a bucket or pan, NOT ON THE GROUND!! All fire/coals must be contained above ground. (No pit or on the ground fires are allowed.)
- 6.** All meats may be seasoned the day before. Meat may not be precooked. NO ingredients may be precooked in any way prior to the commencement of the official cook off.

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- 7.** Judging for chicken will be at 11am, Ribs at 12pm, Pork at 1pm, Brisket at 2pm and People`s Choice is 12pm-2pm.
- 8.** It is responsibility of each team to see that their area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned following the contest. ALL FIRES MUST BE PUT OUT, concrete blocks, wood, charcoal, and ALL equipment, supplies and materials must be hauled away and removed from the site. Coal Disposal bins, and grease barrels will be the responsibility of the cooking teams. It is imperative that the cleanup is thorough.
- 9.** EACH TEAM MUST HAVE AN UPDATED FIRE EXTINGUISHER!!!!
- 10.** The Tavares Chamber of Commerce will supply each team with 500 1 once sample cups and forks (for people`s choice), and 1 roll of paper towels. They will also supply 1 volunteer from 11:45 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. to hand out the 1 oz samples to those that have wristbands. Wristbands are REQUIRED to receive a 1 oz sample.
- 11.** Awards for the competition will be announced around 3:30 p.m. from the entertainment stage.
