Who is eligible for food...

Must live within the boundaries of Patterson to 76th Street and Main Street in Middleville to Alden Nash.

Reservations need to be made ahead of time by calling the Parish Office at 616-891-9259

Upon arrival a valid driver's license and a piece of current 1st class mail must be presented to show proof of residency.

What are the food pantry hours...

Our food pantry is a self shop pantry, meaning you are given assistance with selecting the food that meets your needs. We are open on the 2nd Tuesday of the month, on Tuesday's from 4:30-6pm or Thursday's from 10-11:30am.

What to do if you are in need...

If you or someone you know (who lives within the boundaries listed above) are having difficulty making ends meet, please call the Parish Office at 616-891-9259. All inquiries about receiving food or persons needing food will be kept confidential.



What to do if you would like to help...

We accept food donations year round. The items in need are listed on the left and can be brought to Holy Family and placed on the Food Pantry Cart in the Ministry Hallway.

We are always looking for people who would like to volunteer their time by helping our clients self shop, check in and restocking shelves. If you would like to help out please call the Parish Office.

Absolutely! We will make sure the money you donate goes to help supply our pantry.
