Robotics in Manufacturing: Weeks in June & July TBD, 2020

Reaching over 200 Kindergarten – 8th grade students over 3 weeks of camp. All investors are invited to the showcase at the end of each camp week. Each camp will teach students about manufacturing career opportunities, how robots work in manufacturing environments, programming and coding skills, teamwork, LEAN manufacturing and more!

Manufacturing Week: September 28 – October 2, 2020

Reaching over 3,000 Kindergarten – 12th grade students from a nine-county region. Volunteer opportunities throughout the week.

- ***Manufacturing Career Readiness***

Grades 9-12 students will tour 2-3 manufacturers. Students will learn about career opportunities, post-secondary training requirements; talking with staff to hear about what their jobs entail; learn about production environments; supply chain and how products are used in our region, nation or internationally.

- ***Manufacturing Career Exploration***

Grades 6-8 students will attend an expo to engage in activities related to the four job sectors: design it, produce it, move it, and support it. Manufacturers will showcase career opportunities in the four jobs sectors.

- ***Manufacturing Awareness***

Grades K-5 students will attend a workshop to visit four activities. The students will learn about the manufacturing process, what products are made in Greater Lafayette and where they are used throughout the world, experience the assembly process and learn about manufacturing terms and lean processes.

CoderDojo: Monthly

A free computer science club for kids ages 7-17. Students are invited to come explore their interest in computer programming and work alongside real-life computer science professionals.
