Qualifications:

Must be a senior that either attends a school in Royal Oak or is a resident of Royal Oak and is enrolling in post-secondary education after graduation and majoring in one of the below programs:

General Business, Marketing, Communications, Accounting, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Health Care Management, Human Resources, International Business, Public Administration, Management, Operations Management, Project Management or Information Technology.

Requirements:

Application form fully and accurately completed and turned in by March 20, 2020

Essay questions to be completed and turned in with application.

Available to meet with the selection committee for a brief interview at a TBA April date.

Please Note:

Children of Royal Oak Chamber of Commerce staff and board members are ineligible.

There is no minimum GPA requirement. Please do not include your transcripts or ACT/SAT test scores.

If awarded one of the scholarships, the check will be made out directly to the student. Dollar amount of scholarships are determined by number of students applying and selected. The amount for 2020 will be \$1,000 per scholarship awardee.

Final candidates will be contacted by their school and interviewed by the selection committee comprised of Royal Oak Chamber of Commerce members who will review the application and required material mentioned above. Students who wish to be considered must submit the application materials to their scholarship counselor at his or her school.
