Moss moved to Colorado in 1985 from New Orleans where he attended Loyola University, graduating with a double major in Communications and Social Work. He also has an honorary doctorate degree from the Colorado Institute of Art. He currently serves on the Special Olympics Colorado Board of Directors and the Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation Board of Directors. He is a past board member of more than 12 large not-for-profits in Denver.

Gregg gives a great deal of time to local charities and is a popular program speaker when his schedule permits. He and his wife, Britta, have two amazing sons.
