

SURVEY OF CANADIAN BUSINESS MANAGERS SHOWS STRONG SUPPORT FOR EXPANDED PUBLIC FUNDING OF SOCIAL PROGRAMS

A [Modus Research](#) survey of more than 950 Canadian business managers and executives indicates “remarkable support” for expanded long-term public funding for social programs.

The survey found two-thirds support increases to health care public funding, while 55% support expanded funding for both social housing and basic income.
