



**ONTARIO PRIVATE SECTOR EMPLOYMENT UP SUBSTANTIALLY IN JUNE**

Labour force data from [Statistics Canada](#) indicates total private sector employment in Ontario rose for the second month in a row from the previous and substantial decreases recorded in March and April.

The unadjusted Ontario data from the [June 2020 Labour Force Survey](#) indicates total private sector employment in Ontario was up 9% over May. However, Ontario private sector employment in June remained 9.7% lower in February.

Public sector employment in Ontario increased by 3.1% in June from the previous month. Ontario public sector employment in June remained 6.8% lower than in February.

The total number of self-employed in Ontario increased by 2% in June over the previous month. The number of self-employed in Ontario remains 1.3% lower than in February.

**Ontario: Total Employment by Class of Worker – February 2020 to June 2020**

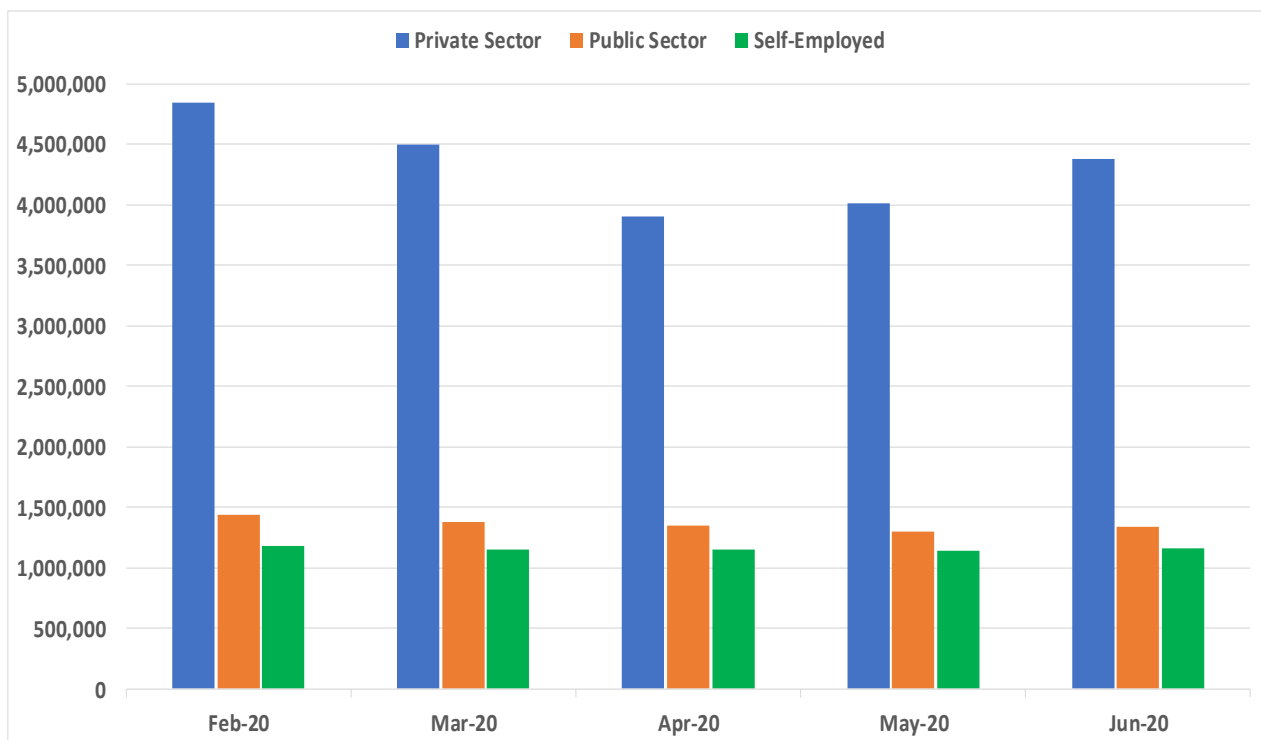
