



RETAIL TRADE SURVEY – MAY 2020

[Statistics Canada](#) has released its [Retail Trade Survey for May 2020](#) and advanced estimates for June 2020.

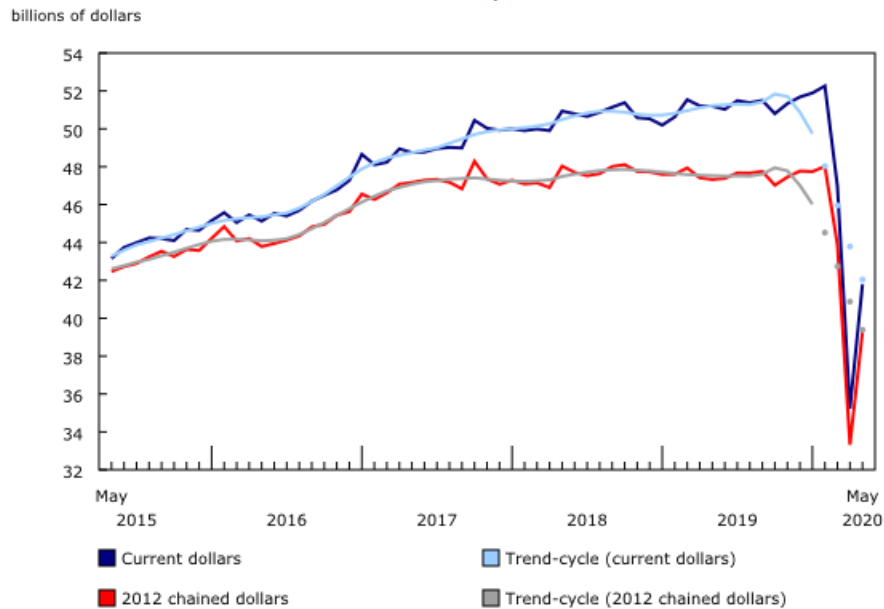
The agency reports retail sales were up 18.7% in May to \$41.8 billion.

- Retail sales up in all but one subsector.
- Retail sales up in every province, led by Quebec and Ontario.
- Retail e-commerce sales were \$3.8 billion in May, accounting for 8.0% of total retail trade.

Statistics Canada's advanced estimates of retail sales for June 2020 suggest that retail sales increased by 24.5% in June.
