



BUILDING PERMITS – JUNE 2020

[Statistics Canada](#) reports total national value of building permits issued by Canadian municipalities in June increased 6.2% to \$8.1 billion, a level comparable to pre-COVID levels.

- Total value of residential permits up 7% in June.
- Total value of non-residential permits rose 4.6% in June, driven largely by a 47.7% increase in institutional permits.

Statistics Canada notes, “Despite the rebound seen in the last two months of the quarter, the value of building permits was down 12.8% compared with the first quarter, a fourth consecutive quarterly decline.”

Figure 1 Month-to-month change in total value of building permits (seasonally adjusted)

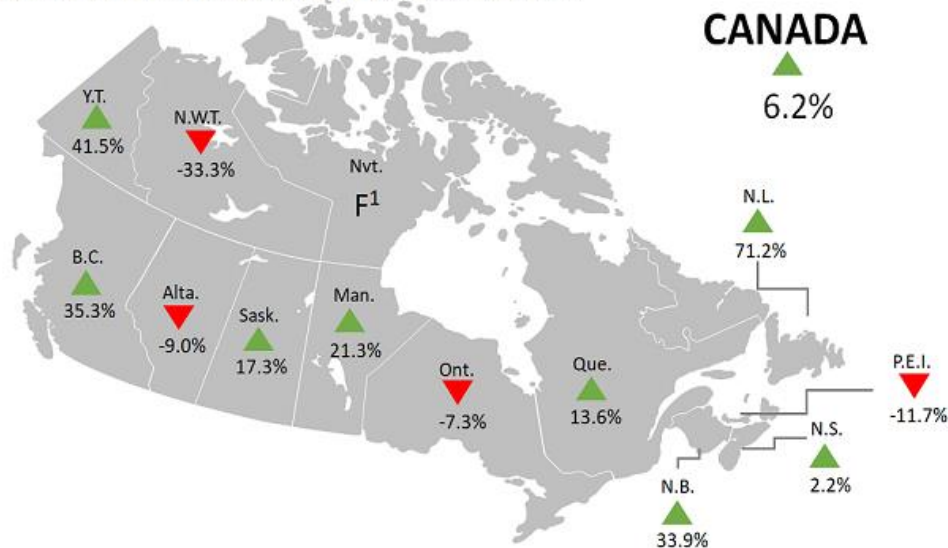


Figure 2 Building permits for residential and non-residential construction in Canada (seasonally adjusted)
