



**ONTARIO LABOUR FORCE SURVEY – JULY 2020**

The [July 2020 Labour Force Survey](#) from [Statistics Canada](#) indicates the following trends for Ontario.

- In Ontario, employment rose by 151,000 (+2.2%) in July, building on an increase of 378,000 in June and bringing employment to 91.7% of its pre-pandemic February level.
- Gains in Ontario employment in July were nearly all in part-time work, while the increase in June was in both full-time and part-time.
- The unemployment rate in Ontario fell by 0.9 percentage points to 11.3% in July.

**Ontario: Total Employment by Class of Worker – February 2020 to July 2020 (Seasonally Unadjusted)**

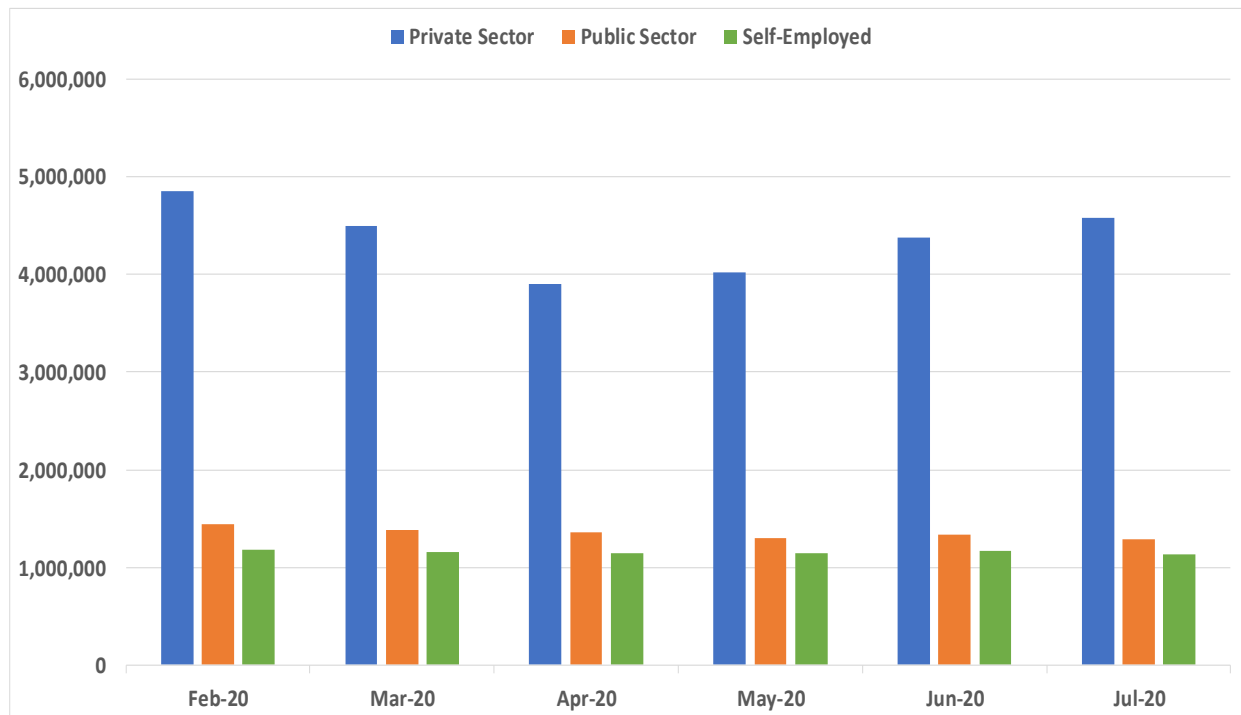
