



GDP BY INDUSTRY – JUNE 2020

[Statistics Canada](#) reports real gross domestic product (GDP) grew 6.5% in June following a 4.8% increase in May. The agency notes, “While May and June’s gains offset some of the March and April declines, economic activity was about 9% below February’s pre-pandemic level.”

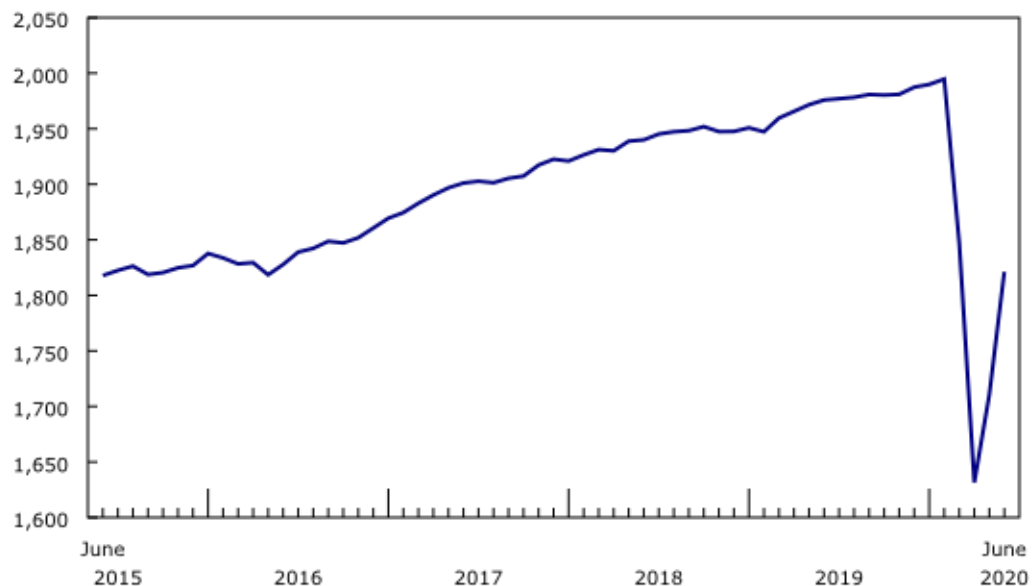
- Both goods-producing (+7.5%) and services-producing (+6.1%) industries were up as 19 of 20 industrial sectors posted increases in June.
- Manufacturing sector GDP grew 14.6% in June following an 8.1% expansion in May.
- Retail Trade GDP jumped 22.3% in June, surpassing the pre-pandemic level of activity.
- Construction sector GDP rose 9.4% in June.
- Accommodation and food services GDP jumped 28.5% in June.
- Transportation and warehousing sector GDP rose 8.0%.

Statistics Canada notes its preliminary assessment for July 2020 indicates an approximate 3% increase in real GDP for July.
